Third Round of Centralised Allotment Process (CAP Round-III)
(Admissions for the Academic Year 2006-2007 to the First Year of Four
Year Full Time Degree Courses in Engineering / Technology)

In pursuance of the orders passed by the Hon'ble High Court, Mumbai in the writ petition (L) no.1629/2006, dated 26/7/2006, the Directorate of Technical Education is conducting third round of Centralised Allotment Process (CAP) for the vacant seats that may be available at the start of Round -III of CAP.

The date of confirmation for admission of CAP round -II is hereby extended till 22nd August 2006. All the candidates to whom seats have been allotted in the CAP round -II will have to confirm the admissions so made, in any event, on or before this last date i.e. 22nd August 2006, failing which the admission(s) so granted shall automatically stand irretrievably cancelled and the seat for which such admission(s) is granted will be treated as vacant and therefore available for grant of admission in the next round.

Eligible Candidates : All Maharashtra State Candidates, whose names have appeared in the Maharashtra State Candidates' Merit list of CAP Round -I are eligible to apply for this CAP round-III, except the following.

Following candidates are not eligible to apply for CAP Round-III:

- All such candidate(s), who were allotted a seat in CAP Round-I and/or II, irrespective of the fact as to whether such candidate(s) have confirmed their respective admission(s) or not.

Seats available: All seats from all the Institutes participating in Centralized Allotment Process (CAP) that is being conducted by the State Government authorities (within the respective sanctioned intake capacity of each of such Institutions) that have remained vacant, on account of whatsoever reason, before the start of CAP Round-III.

Further it is specifically brought to notice of all the candidates that,

- a) CAP Round-III will be conducted for Maharashtra State candidates only. AIEEE vacant seats will be made available for Maharashtra State candidates.
- b) There shall be only one stage of allotment in this Round.
- c) Seats available shall be allotted solely on the basis of inter-se merit determined as per the MHT-CET-2006 merit list without any reference whatsoever to the category of the candidate(s) (open /reserved/male/female) or the category to which the vacant seat belongs (such as AIEEE, Home University, other than Home University, Backward Class, Defense, Physically Handicapped and Ladies etc.).
- d) All available vacant seats shall be treated as 100% State Level seats.

General notes:

1. The aforesaid decision is taken to prevent loss of academics and to make this Round- III meaningful and effective rather than formal and ineffective in view of the previous experience of the Directorate as also the facts and figures available with the Directorate as to the seats remaining vacant at the end of each Round(s) and especially at the end of all the Round(s) of such Centralised Allotment Process. The round is so designed with the purpose that, maximum vacant seats are filled in, without creating further resultant vacancies on account of shifting of students to whom already allotment has been made in first two rounds of CAP. This step was required to enable the colleges to start the academic activity immediately to complete the term in time.
2. Maximum of only four (4) choice codes will be available in the preference form to be submitted for this Round-III.
3. Candidate will be able to take a printout of the online submitted preference form and the same should be confirmed at any of the designated ARCs of CAP Round-II.
4. Candidates are required to pay **Rs.100/- in cash** at ARCs as a processing fee of CAP round-III as this third round was not contemplated and hence are recovered before the holding of this round.
5. Eligible candidates desiring to participate are required to submit **separate and fresh choice codes** for the CAP Round-III.
6. **All the Candidate(s) to whom seat(s) will be allotted in this CAP round-III will not be considered eligible for grant of admission in case of an unlikely event of continuation of the Centralised Allotment Process.**
