ADMISSION TO FIRST YEAR OF FOUR YEAR DEGREE COURSE IN PHARMACY

This Notification is being issued for publication of provisional merit, submission of grievances, if any, submission and confirmation of application form and selection of candidates to be admitted in State Government/Aided Colleges, University Managed Institutes, University Departments, Such Unaided colleges and/or such number of seats from Unaided colleges which by mutual consent have decided to form part of this admission process of Pharmacy Course for the Academic Year 2011-12.

The basic eligibility for admission to First Year Degree Course in Pharmacy is revised as follows:

Candidate should be an Indian National and should have passed the HSC (Std.XII) examination of Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination with subjects English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Mathematics **AND** Secured minimum **45% marks** i.e. not less than 135 marks out of 300 marks (minimum **40% marks** i.e. not less than 120 marks out of 300 marks in case of candidates of Backward class categories belonging only to Maharashtra State) **in the subjects Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Mathematics** added together (Maximum of marks obtained in Biology/Mathematics shall be considered for the purpose of addition) **AND** Obtained a **non zero score at MHT-CET 2011**.

All those candidates who are now eligible due to change in eligibility are required to submit and confirm the online application form at ARC as per the schedule notified herewith. Those candidates who were not eligible and submitted and confirmed the online application form and now become eligible due to change in eligibility are required to take the fresh Receipt-cum-Acknowledgement from the concern ARC.

All those candidate who failed to submit any of the supporting documents are now allowed to submit the same at respective ARC during the grievances periods i.e. between 6th July 2011 to 8th July 2011.

All those candidate who have submitted and confirmed their online application are required to verify their details in the provisional merit list published on the website and required to report grievances, if any at the ARC as per the schedule notified herewith.

Centralized Admission Process (CAP) for Pharmacy Course:

For the academic year 2011-12, the Competent Authority shall conduct total Three (3) rounds of Centralized Admission. The CAP shall consist of first two (2) rounds of Centralized Allotment wherein eligible candidates (both Maharashtra and OMS) will fill separate/fresh Online Option forms for respective rounds. Third round of CAP shall be conducted by way of counselling only for the eligible Maharashtra State candidates.

Candidates who have filled in and confirmed the Online Application form for Admission to Pharmacy course at ARCs and who have been assigned a merit no. shall be eligible to participate in the CAP.

3. It is **Mandatory** for the candidate (except J&K Migrant) to confirm the Online Option form at ARC and **get the Receipt-cum-Acknowledgement** duly signed by ARC, failing which the candidate will not be considered for allotment.
4. Maharashtra State, OMS candidates are required to pay Rs. 100/- in cash as processing fee for each CAP Rounds.
5. Candidates are required to carry Receipt-cum-Acknowledgement of the application form at time of confirmation of option form.
6. The meritorious students belonging to **Muslim/Sikh/Christian/Parsi/Buddhist** community can avail the Merit-cum-Means Based Scholarship.
