**PREAMBLE:**

As suggested by National Project Implementation Unit, New Delhi, State Steering Committee (SSC) and State Project facilitating Unit (SPFU) shall be the nodal agencies monitoring the implementation of TEQIP-II in the state. As per project norms, State Steering Committee (SSC) under the chairmanship of Principle Secretary, Higher and Technical Education is formed vide Government resolution in reference. Formation of State Project Facilitating Unit (SPFU) was under consideration of the Government.

**RESOLUTION:**

As recommended in Project Implementation Plan of TEQIP, Phase-II, State Project Facilitating Unit (SPFU) with following functional units is required to be established within the department and shall be responsible for the monitoring of the project in the state.

1. Academic unit
2. Procurement unit
3. Financial Management Unit
4. Monitoring & Evaluation unit

In view of above norms, Dr. Abhay Wagh, Deputy Secretary, Higher and Technical Education who is working in a specially created Mantralaya Cell in Directorate of Technical Education to facilitate smooth monitoring of the project with close co-ordination with GoI and World-Bank officials is appointed as State Project Advisor (SPA) for TEQIP and shall head the project. Dr. S. K. Mahajan, Director (i/c), Technical Education is appointed as Chief Coordinator and Financial Advisor of the project with a authority for all kinds of financial disbursements under the project. State Project Advisor and Chief Coordinator shall jointly be responsible for signing the Memorandum of Understanding with participating institutes in the project. Shri Pramod Naik, Joint Director, Technical

Education shall assist the State Project Advisor as project Coordinator.

He shall also be responsible for his original charge in Higher and Technical Education Department, Mantralaya and other policy matters of technical education related to Central Government and administrative work related to this project.

The services of Shri. P. S. Rewankar, Associate Professor, Government College of Engineering, Amaravati, Dr. S. S. Bhamare, Sr. Lecturer, Government Polytechnic, Pune, Shri. A. B. Nandgaonkar, Sel. Logistic arrangement for all SPFU officials shall be provided in Mantralaya cell, already established in the office premises of Directorate of Technical Education.
