- 4) Front page should clearly specify Event Name, Branch, Paper Title and Authors with Name of the Institute.
- 5) **Registration fee in the form of DD of Rs.200 per paper drawn in favour of "Principal, Government Polytechnic, Aurangabad" should be submitted along with paper.**
- 6) Participants should send two hard copies & a soft copy (on CD only) of paper on or before **6th Feb 2010**. They should also send papers as mail attachments.
- 7) 8 minutes will be provided to every team for presentation which will be followed by Question & Answer Session.
- 8) Registration form duly signed by Head of Organization with contact numbers of Authors should be submitted with papers.
- 9) LCD projector and Computer Setup will be provided for presentation.
