for the academic year 2010-2011**

1.0 General:

These rules are applicable for admission to Direct Second Year of Four Year Degree Courses in Engineering/ Technology in the following Autonomous Institutes for the academic year 2010-11.

1. Veermata Jijabai Technological Institute (VJTI), Mumbai,
2. Pune Institute of Engineering & Technology (PIET), Pune (Formerly Govt. College of Engineering, Pune) ,
3. Shri. Guru Gobind Singhji Institute of Engineering & Technology (SGGSIE&T), Nanded.
4. Walchand College of Engineering, Sangli.
5. Vishwakarma Institute of Technology, Pune.

These rules also incorporate the guidelines for admission to direct second year degree courses in Engineering/Technology admissions to be carried out by the Autonomous Unaided institute (Vishwakarma Institute of Technology, Pune) for the seats remaining vacant after the completion of centralised admission process. (Ref. Annexure-III).

1.2 Definitions:

- 'State Government' means the Government of Maharashtra.
- 'Director VJTI' means the Director of Veermata Jijabai Technological Institute, Matunga, Mumbai..
- 'Competent Authority' means the authority appointed by the autonomous institutes to, invite applications, and implement the admission procedure as prescribed in the brochure. Director of V.J.T.I is the competent authority.
- 'Representative of the Competent Authority' means an officer appointed to assist Competent Authority for smooth conduct of Admission Process as per the directives of the Competent Authority.
- Application form Receipt Center (ARC) is an institution/center from where a candidate can submit application form.
- 'College' or 'Institution' means Engineering College or Technological Institution duly approved by the AICTE and Government of Maharashtra to impart Education in Engineering and Technology at degree level.
- 'Government Engineering College' means the Engineering College runs by the Government of Maharashtra.
- 'Government Aided Engineering College / Institute' means Engineering College / Institute runs by private management but which receives financial assistance from the Government of Maharashtra.
- 'Un-Aided Engineering College / Institute means Engineering College / Institute runs by private management on self- financing basis.
- Autonomous Institute means the institute for which autonomy is granted by the Govt. of Maharashtra.
- 'Sanctioned Intake' means the course wise number of seats sanctioned by the Government Resolution with reference to the AICTE's approval.
- '*Inter se* merit' means the order of merit as defined by Maharashtra State Merit list.
- 'Candidate' means an applicant who desires to seek admission to Second Year of four year Degree Courses in Engineering/Technology in Maharashtra State by submitting the prescribed application form.
- 'Course' means four year degree course/programme in Engineering/Technology.
- "Diploma" means Diploma awarded by the Maharashtra State Board of Technical Education, or Diploma awarded by AICTE approved autonomous polytechnics in Maharashtra state or its equivalent.

2.0 Eligibility:

2.1 Educational Qualification

The candidate must be an Indian National and should have passed Post-SSC or Post-HSC Diploma course in Engineering/Technology with **minimum 60.00 %** marks

- of the Maharashtra State Board of Technical Education (**MSBTE**)
- OR**
- of any other recognized Diploma equivalent¹ to the diploma awarded by the Maharashtra State Board of Technical Education (**MSBTE**) with *English as the medium of instruction* at diploma level.
- OR**
- of any other AICTE approved institution which has been granted academic autonomy by the Government of Maharashtra or University in the State of Maharashtra.

¹**Note:** Such candidates shall produce Equivalence certificate from MSBTE, 4th floor, Govt. Polytechnic Building, 49, Kherwadi, Ali Yavar Jung Marg, Bandra (E), Mumbai-400051 (www.msbt.com) at the time of submission of application form for admission

2.2 Criteria for eligibility as Maharashtra State candidate:

A candidate is considered eligible for admission to direct second year of Degree courses in Engineering / Technology through **CAP** subject to fulfillment of any one of the eligibility criteria as listed in the following table.

2.3 General notes on Eligibility:

- Candidate Passing SSC (Std. X)/ HSC (Std. XII) / any other equivalent examination and /or Diploma Examination as specified in rule 2.1 from a recognized institution situated outside the State of Maharashtra.

AND

not satisfying any of the conditions stated in Sr. No. 2, 3, 4 (i.e. Type B,C,D) above as regards to their parent's status are not eligible for admission through CAP and also in Autonomous Govt./Govt. Aided/ Autonomous Un -Aided institutes for any subsequent institute level rounds.

- Admission of any candidate made at the institution shall be provisional, subject to the final eligibility certification from the concerned University. If candidate fails to get eligibility, his admission may be cancelled at any stage.

3.0 Allocation and Reservation of Seats:

3.1 Seats available for admission to direct Second year: These seats are classified as follows:

- The seats available with the Competent Authority for the CAP are as follows
 - a. Lateral Entry seats = LE = $1/6$ of Sanctioned Intake, which will be over and above, supernumerary to the approved intake.
 - b. Seats remaining vacant within sanctioned intake (S): in addition to above, vacant seats (S) in a course, $S=SI-(SI-C-F+B-L+P)$, and if $S>0$, may also be available. where

SI	=	Sanctioned Intake
C*	=	No of cancellations at the first year level
F*	=	No. of students not eligible for admission to second year as per rules/rules by affiliating University or autonomous institute
B*	=	No of students who belongs to earlier batches who have become eligible for admission to second year as per rules/rules by affiliating University or autonomous institute
L*	=	No. of students shifted from the Institute to another Institute for the second year.
P*	=	No. of students who shifted to the Institute from another Institute for the second year.

Students admitted against any type of supernumerary seat/s shall not be considered in C,F,B,L or P

If the result of the Institute is not declared till the last date of calculation of the Vacant Seats within SI as per schedule, then the value of B is to be taken as total number of candidates who belong to earlier batches and appeared for examination during last academic year.

Transfer as per **GR No. PEC.3090/59083(6342)**, dated 1st August 1994 of the **Department of Higher and Technical Education, Maharashtra State**, or subsequent Government order if any.

- * Transfer to the course shall be effected only after accommodating repeaters, to such an extent if and only if the $S>0$ after declaration of result.

3.1.1 Seats available for admission through Competent Authority:

100% of the seats available with the competent authority in all above mentioned institutions shall be filled through CAP.

3.1.2 Seats available with the Institutes:

Seats remaining vacant after CAP Rounds: After completion of the CAP Rounds, if any vacancy remain from amongst the total number of seats available with the Competent Authority either due to non allotment, cancellations or due to non reporting of candidates, will be permitted to be filled by the respective institutes with prior approval from the **Competent Authority** subject to the condition that the class strength will not exceed NCS confirmed by the Competent Authority.

3.2 Allocation of seats: The available seats in Subgroup shall be divided in the ratio of eligible applications received from the candidates passing diploma in **(a)** Annual pattern, and in **(b)** Semester pattern; using normal rules of rounding off. However, minimum of one seat will be reserved for either. If there are no applications from eligible Diploma holders either from Annual pattern or from Semester pattern, all the seats available for distribution will be allotted to the candidates from which applications are available.

Note :- The above Rule shall be more clear from the following example :-

3.3 Reservation of seats: There will not be any seats reserved for Backward Class Category Candidates or any other Categories such as Physically Handicapped, Defence, Girls etc. for Admission to Direct Second Year.

4.0 Group and Subgroup of courses for admissions:

The groups and subgroups of diploma courses and corresponding degree courses for which admissions to direct second year shall be given are as below. Admissions will be effected to Diploma holders of a subgroup for Degree Courses mentioned in the same subgroup. Thereafter "vacant seats", if any, will be offered to candidates from other subgroups (Diploma), under the same group, who are eligible for corresponding degree courses from the group. For this purpose group merit list will be operated.

5.0 Assignment of Merit Number:

5.1 Merit Number:

- The admission shall be offered strictly on the basis of *inter se* merit of the Candidates.
- *Inter se* Merit shall be determined on the basis of marks obtained at the Final Year or Final Semester / Semesters of Diploma Examination on the basis of which the Diploma has been awarded by the examining authority. **In case of grades, index, credits etc. a certified copy of the method for conversion into equivalent marks declared by the relevant examination authority should be attached with the application.**

5.2 Relative merit in case of tie:

In case of candidates securing equal number of marks, their relative *inter se* merit shall be determined in the following order:

- (a) A candidate passing the SSC (Std. X) examination with higher percentage of aggregate marks.
- (b) A candidate passing the SSC (Std. X) examination with higher marks in Mathematics.
- (c) A candidate passing the SSC (Std. X) examination with higher marks in Science.
- (d) An older candidate shall be preferred over a younger candidate.

The merit list shall be published as per schedule showing the state level general merit number, Annual/Semester Pattern state level general merit number, Sub Group/Main Group/Special Group general merit number, Sub Group/Main Group/ Special Group Annual/Semester Pattern merit number.

6.0 Admission Rounds:

For the academic year 2010-11, the Competent Authority shall conduct total Three (03) rounds of Centralized Admission.

Summary of "Rules of Reporting" in CAP is as follows:

Reporting at Admission Centre:

a) The candidates from respective group shall report personally to the Admission Authorities at the centers indicated in Table No. 1, as per the schedule displayed on websites, with all original certificates needed to substantiate the claims made in the application regarding eligibility as specified in 2.2.

b) If a candidate is unable to produce original certificates at the time of his or her admission on account of admission already secured to some other institution, he or she shall produce a certificate from the Head of the Institution where he or she has already taken admission indicating that he or she has been admitted to a particular course in that institution on a particular date and hence original certificates have been retained in that institution. The candidate shall produce the attested copies of the certificates, duly attested by the Head of the concerned Institution.

c) The candidate submitting a certificate from Head of the Institution as per Rule 6-b, shall be required to pay the fees immediately at the time of admission. The candidate will have to submit the required original certificates to the institute to which admitted within 4 working days after the date of payment of fees.

d) In case, any candidate can not report at the Admission Centre personally at the scheduled date and time because of circumstances beyond his or her control, he or she may authorise some representative, preferably a close relative, to report at the Admission Centre through an authorization letter in the format given in 'Pro forma -F' along with original certificates and necessary fees. The candidate shall justify with reasons for not reporting personally. The decision taken by his / her representative regarding selection of a course / or Institute shall be binding on the candidate.

e) After scrutiny of original documents, if the candidate is offered admission to any course, according to inter se merit and availability of seats, the candidate will have to pay prescribed fees immediately and secure the admission offered to him or her. If a candidate fails to pay the requisite fees in the mode of payment of fee as specified in rule 7.1 and 7.2, the offer of admission made to him or her shall stand cancelled and the seat will be offered to the immediate next eligible candidate in merit.

f) If any candidate fails to report in person or fails to depute authorised representative for scrutiny of his or her application and subsequent offer of admission according to inter se merit, at the time and

date prescribed for him or her, he or she will forfeit claim for admission to any course available at that point of time and the seat will be offered to the next eligible candidate in the merit list.

g) If a candidate reports to the Admission Authority later than the time given, he or she shall be considered for admission against the seats available in his / her category at the time of reporting if that particular round of admission is still going on.

6.1: CAP Rounds I/II/III (Admission by Counseling):

6.1.1 CAP Rounds I /II/III (Admission by Counseling):

- For the CAP Round-I, Stage-I & Stage-IV of rule 6.1.2 shall be executed. Seats remaining vacant due to non-admission and non-reporting will be available for admission in CAP Round-II.
- For the CAP Round-II Stage-IV of rule 6.1.2 shall be executed. Seats remaining vacant due to non-admission and non-reporting will be available for admission in CAP Round-III.
- For the CAP Round-III, Stage-IV of rule 6.1.2 shall be executed. Seats remaining vacant due to non-admission and non-reporting will be available for admission in Institute level Round-(Annexure-III)

In any case, once candidate admitted directly to the second year of a course in any Institute any one CAP round shall not eligible in subsequent round i.e if candidate admitted in CAP round -I, directly to the second year of a course in any Institute shall not be eligible for CAP-Round -II, CAP Round III and Institute Level round and similarly.

6.1.2 Logic of offer a seat for admission of Subgroup and Group courses for Semester and Annual Pattern:

As per the calculation of seats given by rules 3.1 and 3.2, vacancies will be calculated for annual and semester pattern separately and admission of seats for subgroups and special groups will be done as per inter se merit as shown below.

Stage-I (Sub-group Round with separate merit list of Semester and Annual pattern)

- Stage-1A – Admission of seat for **annual pattern** will be done by operating annual pattern merit list for the respective subgroups.
- Stage-1B – Admission of seat for **semester pattern** will be done by operating semester pattern merit list for respective subgroups.

Stage-II (Sub-group Round with combined merit list of Semester and Annual pattern)

On completion of Stage-I, admission of courses in the subgroup will be made to the candidate for available seats after Stage –I strictly according to the combined merit list of the annual and semester pattern sub-group candidates.

Stage –III (Group Round with separate merit list of Semester and Annual pattern)

On completion of Stage–II, the seats remaining vacant in the respective Group will be allotted to the candidates strictly according to their inter se merit and by operating annual and semester pattern Group merit list separately i.e. as per the division of the seats between annual pattern and semester pattern.

Stage –IV (Group Round with combined merit list of Semester and Annual pattern)

The seats remaining vacant after Stage–III will be allotted to the candidates strictly according to the combined merit list of the annual and semester pattern for the entire Group.

7.0 Fees and Concessions:

7.1 Fees prescribed in Autonomous Government and Autonomous Government Aided: As per the relevant Govt. resolution the annual tuition, development and other fees (Approximate) for the Autonomous Government and Autonomous Government aided Engineering Institutes is as indicated below

Above mentioned fees are indicative figures. Final fee of the second year of respective institutes will be made available at the time of confirming the admission at institute.

7.1.1 Mode of payment of fees: Open category candidate who has been offered a seat shall pay the prescribed tuition fees (RS 15,000/-) in the form of **D.D.(Demand Draft) / Pay Order / Bankers Cheque of any scheduled bank**. No other mode of payment shall be permitted. Demand Draft /Pay Order/ Bankers cheque should be drawn in the name of **"Director, VJTI, Mumbai"** payable at Mumbai. **No fee shall be charged from reserve category candidates at the time of admission.**

Note:- For VIT, Pune, at the time of admission (CAP- rounds) only Rs 15,000/- tuition fee will be collected from the candidates in form of mode of payment described above, but student have to pay the difference in tuition fee at the time of confirmation of admission in the institute along with other fees.

7.2 Fees prescribed in Autonomous Unaided Engineering College (Vishwakarma Institute of Technology, Pune):

The interim fee structure for Autonomous unaided engineering college approved by the Shikshan Shulka Samiti will be made available at the time of admission. Autonomous Unaided Engineering Colleges may have submitted their proposals for revision in fees to Shikshan Shulka Samiti. The revision in the fees if any, by the Shikshan Shulka Samiti will be binding on the students who will be admitted in the year 2010-11 and the students taking admission in this institute will have to pay the fees accordingly.

7.3 University fees:

Candidates shall be required to pay fees as prescribed by the concerned University from time to time.

7.4 Caution Money deposits:

Caution money deposits received from the students shall be refunded after successful completion of the course or after canceling the admission. Unless there is any recovery, no deduction shall be made from the caution money deposit. However, the amount of caution money deposit shall be transferred to Students Aid Fund in case of Un-Aided colleges and credited to institute in case of Autonomous Government and Government-Aided College, if candidate does not apply for refund, within three complete financial years after the student actually leaves the institution; or, within three complete financial years after the date of successful completion of the course, whichever is earlier.

7.5 Refund of Tuition, Development and Other fees after cancellation of admission secured through CAP round, in Institute level round(s) and in Vacancy Round(s) of admissions in Autonomous Government, Autonomous Government Aided, and Autonomous Unaided Institutes:

The candidate who has been provisionally admitted may cancel admission by submitting an application in duplicate, in the prescribed pro forma - C and may request for refund of fees. The refund of fees as applicable shall be made in due course. It is made clear that such application for cancellation will be considered if and only if the admission is confirmed by paying the prescribed tuition fee and other fees in full and by submitting the original documents. Refund shall be made after deduction of the cancellation charges as shown below:

Note:

1. Amount of Security/Caution Money Deposit is to be refunded entirely to candidate.
2. * For the calculation of amount on the pro-rata basis, one month shall be treated as one unit e.g. if the candidate cancels the admission on third day after start of the academic session and the seat is filled on/before the cutoff date, then cancellation amount will be, total fees/12 or Rs. 1000/-, whichever is higher.

7.6 Concession in Tuition and Other fees:

All the schemes given below, regarding concession in tuition & other fees shall be available to candidates belonging to Maharashtra State only subject to the fulfillment of the eligibility criteria specified by respective authorities offering such concession in fees from time to time.

7.6.1 E.B.C. Concession:

Candidates claiming concessions for Economically Backward Class (E.B.C.) shall produce a certificate from the Executive Magistrate to the effect that the candidate belongs to EBC category at the time of admission. They shall, on admission, also submit an application in the prescribed form for being granted the concession of free education, to the appropriate authorities through the college to which they are admitted within one month from the actual date of joining of college or as may be required. The students shall note that applications received after the due date may not be considered and in that case, they will have to pay the necessary fees.

The concessions in tuition fee at the time of admission will be given only for Autonomous Govt., Govt. Aided, Colleges

The scheme/ mode of concessions, scheme of loan scholarship (if any) for eligible EBC candidates, in tuition & other fees in the Autonomous Un-Aided Institution will be announced by the State Government.

7.6.2 Concession in fees for Backward Class Category Candidates (belonging to Maharashtra State only) in Autonomous Unaided Private Institutes: (For SC/ST/VJ DT NT (A)/NT (B)/NT(C)/NT (D)/SBC /OBC category candidates)

The scheme/mode of concessions, scheme of loan scholarship (if any) for eligible SC/ST/VJ DT NT(A)/NT(B)/NT(C)/NT(D)/SBC /OBC category candidates, in tuition &

other fees in the Autonomous Un-Aided Institutions will be announced by the State Government.

However, these candidates will get only that amount of waiver as notified in the circulars issued by the Social Justice and Tribal Welfare Departments from time to time, subject to fulfillment of various norms and conditions lay down by these Departments.

Note:

- Candidates claiming for the fee concession under reservation category shall produce the requisite certificates as may be specified by the respective Social Justice and Tribal Welfare Departments.
- **Strict action will be taken by the State Govt. against the institutes violating these norms.**

7.6.3 Scholarship Scheme for Students Belonging to Minority Communities

Students belonging to Muslim/ Christian/ Buddhist/ Shikh/ Parsi community can apply through the admitted Institutes for the 'Merit-cum- Means Based Scholarship Scheme' of Government of India.

8.0 Actions to be taken in case of excess admissions, late uploading of admitted candidates and refund of fees after cancellation of admission

8.1 Excess admissions

- Excess admissions over the sanctioned intake shall not be allowed under any circumstances.
- In case any excess admission is reported/noted by the DTE, appropriate penal action will be initiated against the Institution.
- The Institution shall be liable to punitive action from any one or more of the following by the DTE.
 - surcharge amounting five times the total fees collected per student shall be levied against each excess admission
 - seats equal to double the number of excess admissions shall be reduced from intake in the subsequent academic year
 - Suspension of approval for supernumerary seats
 - No admission status in one/more courses
 - Withdrawal of approval for programme/course
 - Withdrawal of approval of the Institution
 - Institution shall be listed as defaulter and defaulter list shall be communicated to AICTE and will be published on DTE website for the information of general public

8.2 Late uploading of Admitted candidates on DTE web site.

- After the allotment of the seat in each CAP Round, candidates should report to the "Respective Institutes" as per the notified schedule of the admission process.
- Candidates shall report to the concerned institute with all original certificates needed to substantiate the claims made in the application regarding eligibility.

- After scrutiny of original documents at the concerned institute, the candidate will have to pay prescribed full fees immediately in the form as prescribed by the concerned institute and confirm the admission offered.
- The Director/Principal of the respective Institute is required to carry out "Online Update" of the confirmation/cancellation of the candidate's admission on website through their Institute login, at the time when the candidate is being admitted/cancelled at the Institute.
- The system shall automatically generate letter of confirmation/cancellation of the admission as an acknowledgement.
- The institute is required to take a printout of the acknowledgement and then the status of candidate will change to 'Reported Candidate'.
- If a candidate fails to substantiate the claims made at the time of submitting the application form by submitting the necessary original documents and fails to pay the prescribed fees in full within the reporting time for CAP Round, the candidate forfeits the claim on the allotted seat immediately.
- It is the responsibility of the Director/Principal of concerned institute to update the status of the reporting of the candidate. If the institute fails to update the status of reporting in scheduled time, then such unreported seat(s) will be filled in subsequent CAP rounds and the institute will be responsible for further consequences.
- If the institute fails to update the status of Cancellation of the candidate on the date of cancellation through "Online Update", then strict action shall be taken against such institutes. It is mandatory to cancel the admission through online system only and issue the printout of the "Online Receipt of the Cancellation" to the candidate with due seal and signature of the authority of the institute.
- The CAP allotment list will be available to the institute through their Institute Login. The list can be collected from Regional Offices also. The Institute should update the information of the reported candidates, allotted under CAP "Online update" when a candidate is reporting to the Institute.
- Rounds of admission for Institute Level Seats and for the seats remaining vacant after CAP should be carried out separately and it should be clearly displayed on the Notice board of the institute
- The Director/Principal of the institute has to also update the list of all admitted candidates on the DTE website through their institute login clearly indicating the stage of their admission like CAP, Against CAP vacancy, Institute level/ Minority seats, etc. within 5 days from the cut off date of the admission.
- If the institute fails to update the reporting of the candidate through "Online Update", the action shall be taken against the institute as per the GR dated 29.03.2008.
- The Director/Principal of the institute is required to update the list of all admitted candidates of CAP and Against CAP Vacancy Seats immediately as per the schedule of admission on the DTE website through their institute login.
- Three copies of list are to be printed and to be submitted to the concerned Regional Office of Technical Education, duly signed by the Director/Principal / Head of the Institute within 7 days from the cut off date.
- The regional office of the Joint Director of Technical Education shall verify the supporting documents and forward the list of admitted candidate to the Director, Technical Education along with the remarks of Joint Director for final approval.
- The DTE and/or Pravesh Niyantaran Samiti, Mumbai shall accord the final approval to the list of admitted candidates. It is binding on all the Universities to grant enrollment only to the students who are on approved list.

Important Note: All the institutes are required to complete their admission process on or before the cut-off date as specified in the schedule. Any admission carried out after cut-off date will not be approved by DTE and/or Pravesh Niyantran Samiti, Mumbai.

8.3 Refund Cases after cancellation of admission

Institutions not following guidelines given by AICTE regarding refund of fees on cancellations or delaying refunds shall be liable to following punitive action from any one or more of the following by the AICTE/DTE.

- Surcharge amounting two times the total fees collected per student shall be levied against each case regarding refund.
- Seats equal to double the number of such cases shall be reduced from intake in the subsequent academic year.

Suspension of approval for supernumerary seats, if any

9.0 Miscellaneous:

- (a) The medium of instruction is English.
- (b) Candidates admitted to a course in Engineering / Technology will have to produce the Eligibility Certificate from the University to which the College is affiliated. If candidate fails to produce eligibility certificate his / her admission will be cancelled at any stage.
- (c) Candidate once admitted directly to the second year of a course in any college shall not be eligible for transfer to any other institution during the same academic year.**
- (d) Head of the institution may refer the candidate to the appropriate medical authority for ascertaining the physical fitness of the candidate to undergo the requirements of the course.
- (e) Head of the institution may verify the antecedents of the candidate through the appropriate police authority.
- (f) Any other matter not specifically covered by these rules shall be decided by the Director of V.J.T.I and his decision will be final.**

10.0 Hostel accommodation:

Accommodation in hostels is not guaranteed. Candidates are advised to verify personally whether the hostel accommodation is available or not by contacting Directors/Principals of concerned colleges. Hostel fees should also be ascertained by the candidates from the Directors/Principals before taking admission.

11.0 Conduct and Discipline:

- Notwithstanding anything contained in these Rules, if the State Government, after consultation with the Vice-Chancellor of the University / Chairman of Board, and after making such enquiry as it may deem fit, is of the opinion that there were serious malpractice or unfair means used at any qualifying examination of University or Board, such as intensive copying, the State Government may, by order, prescribed additional test or examination for the students who have appeared at that examination and who seek direct admission to second year of the engineering colleges.
- Students while studying in any Engineering college, if found indulging in antinational activities contrary to the provisions of Acts and Laws enforced by Government, any activity contrary to the rules of discipline will be liable to be expelled from the college without any notice by the Director/Principal of the concerned college.
- If any of the statement made in application form or any information supplied by the candidate in connection with his / her admission is later on, at any time, found to be false or incorrect, his/her admission will be cancelled, fee forfeited and he / she may be

expelled from the college by the principal or / and prosecuted, if deemed necessary. An appeal against the order of expulsion, however, may be preferred within 8 days from the date of letter of expulsion, to the Director of Technical Education whose decision in such cases will be final.

- **Action Against Ragging: Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act 1999 which is in effect from 15th May 1999 has the following provisions for Action against Ragging.**
 - a) Ragging within or outside of any educational institution is prohibited
 - b) Whosoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets, or propagates ragging within or outside any educational institution shall, on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term up to 2 years and / or penalty which may extend to ten thousand rupees.
 - c) Any student convicted of an offence of ragging shall be dismissed from the educational institution and such student shall not be admitted in any other educational institution for a period of five years from the date of order of such dismissal.
 - d) Whenever any student or, as the case may be, the parent or guardian or a teacher of an educational institution complains, in writing, of ragging to the head of the educational institution, the head of the educational institution shall, without prejudice to the foregoing provisions, within seven days of the receipt of the complaint, enquire into the matter mentioned in the complaint and if, prima facie, it is found true, suspend the student who is accused of the offence, and shall, immediately forward the complaint to the police station having jurisdiction over the area in which the educational institution is situated, for further action. Where, on enquiry by the head of the educational institution, it is found that there is no substance, prima facie, in the complaint received; he /she shall intimate the fact, in writing, to the complainant. The decision of the head of the educational institution shall be final.
 - e) If the head of the educational institution fails or neglects to act in the manner specified in section "d" above when a complaint of ragging is made, such person shall be deemed to have abetted the offence and shall, on conviction, be punished as provided for in section "b" above.

Legal jurisdiction: All disputes pertaining to the admission shall fall within the jurisdiction of Mumbai High Court, bench at Mumbai only. The Competent Authority shall be the legal person in whose name the Government of Maharashtra may sue or may be sued.

- ***Domicile Certificate:**

Domicile certificate issued by the **Maharashtra State's** appropriate authorities, will be considered valid. The domicile certificate of Mother of the candidate should have been issued after her marriage, such certificate issued before her marriage will not be valid. In case of mother's domicile certificate, the candidate shall submit an affidavit on Rs.100/- stamp paper, stating that the person in whose name the domicile certificate is issued is the mother of the candidate.

- ****Caste Validity Certificate:-**

Candidates belonging to SC, ST, VJ/DT NT (A), NT (B), NT(C), SBC and OBC category are required to produce Caste Validity Certificate at the time of filling of confirmation of admission. However such candidates who are unable to produce the caste validity certificate may produce the same on or before 30th November 2010. If a candidate fails to submit the required Caste Validity Certificate up to 30th November 2010 then such candidate shall not be eligible for taking benefits of respective category, if any.

- **@Non-Creamy Layer Certificate:-**

A candidate belonging to 'Creamy Layer' amongst the categories SBC, V.J./N.T.(A), N.T.(B), N.T.(C), N.T.(D) and O.B.C. must note that the provision of reservation is NOT applicable to him/her. A candidate claiming benefit of reservation under the categories SBC, V.J./N.T.(A), N.T.(B), N.T.(C), N.T.(D) and O.B.C. will be required to produce "Non-Creamy Layer Certificate" as per Performa D as specified in the Government Resolution No. CBC/10/2006/CR-15/MVK-5, dated 30th June 2006. The certificate must be valid up to 31st March 2011.

- **Attestation:**

Candidate should note the following points while submitting the Application form:

- Candidate shall attach attested copies of all the required Certificates as mentioned in the rules and enumerate the same in the given format as applicable. Candidate shall not attach a copy of any other Certificate, which is not asked for under these rules such as Certificates for participation in sports, cultural activities etc.
- The copies of Certificates or documents attached to the application form should be attested by the Principal of the college from which the Candidate has passed Qualifying Examination or Gazetted Officer or Special Executive Magistrate or Head Master of a Secondary School or Teaching Staff of Government College/Polytechnic not below the rank of a lecturer. Original Certificates should not be attached with the application form.

- **Translation:**

If the candidate produces any certificate, which is not in Marathi or Hindi or English language, authenticated Marathi or Hindi or English version of the same, duly attested by a Gazetted Officer shall also be produced.

- **Cut off date for the eligibility:**

The eligibility of the candidate shall be determined and/or decided for all purposes including for applicability of all these Rules and Regulations by considering the last date of submission and confirmation of Application form as the **cut off date**. It is made abundantly clear that if a candidate is found ineligible as on the last date of submission and confirmation of Application form, in terms of these Rules and Regulations, and if such an ineligible candidate acquires the requisite eligibility after the aforesaid cut off date (i.e. the last date of submission and confirmation of Application form), **such subsequent acquisition of eligibility will not make an ineligible candidate eligible for any purpose whatsoever, much less for the purpose of admission.**

Admission authority in the institute shall follow the procedure mentioned under Annexure-I and should verify the original documents as mentioned in Annexure-II while confirming the admission of candidates who have been allotted seat through Centralised Admission Process.

A) Guidelines for the Admission Process to be carried out by Autonomous Govt., Autonomous Govt. Aided, and Autonomous Un Aided Institutes:

The seats remaining vacant after the CAP Rounds will be filled by the Principal /Director of the respective institutes at the Institute level. This round will be conducted by counseling for the candidates in the group merit list (Semester and Annual pattern combined).

Eligible Candidates: All the candidates as per entire merged group merit list for semester and annual pattern as per their *inter se* merit prepared by the competent authority and not admitted in CAP Round –I, CAP round-II and CAP round-III

The eligible candidate has to approach to the Principals /Director of the respective institutions for the admission.
