1.0 General:

These rules and information given herein shall be applicable for admission to second year of four-year full time degree course in Pharmacy in

- All Government Institutes in Maharashtra State
- All Government Aided Institutes in Maharashtra State
- All University Managed Pharmacy Institutes in Maharashtra State
- University Departments
- All Unaided Colleges in Maharashtra State.

These rules also incorporate the guidelines for the Unaided institutes for carrying out the direct second year degree Pharmacy admissions for the seats remaining vacant after the completion of centralised allotment process (Ref. Annexure-I).

1.2 Definitions :

- 'State Government' means the Government of Maharashtra.
- 'Director' means the Director of Technical Education, Maharashtra State.
- 'Competent Authority' means the authority appointed by the Government to invite applications, and implement the admission procedure as prescribed in the brochure. Director of Technical Education is the competent authority.
- 'Representative of the Competent Authority' means an officer appointed to assist Competent Authority for smooth conduct of Admission Process as per the directives of the Competent Authority.

- Application form Receipt Center (ARC) is an institution/center where a candidate can fill the specimen application form, submit it and upload it.
- 'College' or 'Institution' means institution duly approved by the AICTE and Government of Maharashtra to impart Education in Pharmaceutical Sciences leading to degree in Pharmacy.
- PCI means Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi
- "Sanctioned Intake", means the course wise number of seats sanctioned by the A.I.C.T.E. and approved by the Government of Maharashtra.
- "Course" means four year degree course / programme in Pharmacy.
- "MSBTE" means Maharashtra State Board of Technical Education.
- "Diploma" means Diploma awarded by the Maharashtra State Board of Technical Education, or equivalent thereto as per ER-91 regulations, which will be considered as "Qualifying Examination" or Diploma awarded by AICTE approved autonomous polytechnics in Maharashtra state.
- "Aided College / Institution" means institution run by private management by receiving grant-in-aid" from State Government or Central Government.
- 'University Managed Pharmacy College / Institute' means Pharmacy College / Institute run by a particular University.
- 'University Department' means a department of University, which offers four year degree programme in Pharmacy.
- 'Un-aided institute' means institution run by private management without receiving grant-in-aid from State Government or Central Government.
- "Management" means the managing body of registered trust or society responsible for managing the Pharmacy College / Institute.
- 'Inter se merit' means the order of merit as defined by Maharashtra State Merit list.
- 'Candidate' means an applicant who desires to seek admission to Second Year of four year Degree Course in Pharmacy in Maharashtra State by submitting the prescribed application form.

2.0 Eligibility

2.1 Educational Qualification.

The candidate must be Indian National and should have passed

- HSC examination with Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Mathematics (or both) from Board of Higher Secondary Examination, Maharashtra State.
Candidates who have not offered either Mathematics or Biology at XII std examination shall have to appear and pass in the particular subject at the examination of XII std conducted by the Higher Secondary Board in Maharashtra State.

AND

- The candidate should have passed in **first class /first class with condonation**, post HSC diploma course in Pharmacy (as per ER-91 regulations of PCI) from an institution **approved by AICTE** and of
 - the Maharashtra State Board of Technical Education (MSBTE)

OR

 - any other recognized diploma¹ equivalent to the diploma awarded by the Maharashtra State Board of Technical Education (MSBTE) with English as the medium of instruction at diploma level.

OR

 - any other AICTE approved institution which has been granted academic autonomy by the Government of Maharashtra or University in the State of Maharashtra.

¹ Such candidates shall produce Equivalence certificate from MSBTE, 4th floor, Govt. Polytechnic Building, 49, Kherwadi, Ali Yavar Jung Marg, Bandra (E), Mumbai- 400 051 (www.msbt.com) at the time of confirmation of application form at ARC.

2.2 Criteria for eligibility as Maharashtra State candidate:

A candidate is considered eligible for admission to direct second year of Pharmacy through CAP subject to fulfillment of any one of the eligibility criteria as listed in the following table.

2.3 General notes on Eligibility :

- Candidate Passing SSC (Std. X)/ HSC (Std. XII) / any other equivalent examination **and / or** Diploma Course in Pharmacy Examination as specified in rule 2.1 from a recognized institution situated outside the State of Maharashtra.
AND
Not satisfying any of the conditions stated in Sr. No. 2, 3, 4 (i.e. Type B,C,D) above as regards to parent's status are not eligible for admission through CAP and also in Govt./Govt. aided / Govt. aided University managed institutes / University Departments for any subsequent institute level rounds. However,

these candidates are eligible for the seats remaining vacant after admitting Maharashtra candidates in the Unaided institutes.

- If the University has prescribed any additional conditions for eligibility of First Class Diploma Holders to Degree course in Pharmacy, the same also shall be applicable for admission to a college affiliated to that University.
- Admission of any candidate made at the institution shall be provisional, subject to the acceptance / production of eligibility certificate from the concerned University and the final approval to the merit list of second year Degree Pharmacy course by the Director of Technical Education, Maharashtra State, Mumbai. If candidate fails to get eligibility, his admission may be cancelled at any stage.
- Candidates admitted to Direct Second Year B. Pharmacy Class will have to appear and pass in the subject of Industrial Psychology prescribed in F.Y. B. Pharmacy syllabus in addition to producing passing certificate in Mathematics / Biology at XII Std Examination of Higher Secondary Board in Maharashtra State, if he / she has not offered / passed in any / both the subjects. Failing to production of this certificate, the student will not be promoted to third year degree in Pharmacy.
- Candidates passing Diploma in Pharmacy from Institution **not approved by AICTE/PCI are not eligible and therefore shall not have any claim on admission.**

3.0 Allocation and Reservation of seats:

3.1 **Seats available for direct Second year admission** : These seats are classified as follows :

- The seats available with the Competent Authority for the first round of allotment
i.e. Lateral entry seats = LE = $1/10^{\text{th}}$ of SI
- The seats available with the Institutes - which are to be filled at the respective Institutes after the competition of the CAP round.
i.e. Seats remaining vacant within Lateral Entry (LE) after CAP Round + seats remaining vacant (VS) within sanctioned intake (Refer rule no. 3.1.2.2)
Total no. of seats available for Direct admission to second year (TS) = LE + VS

3.1.1 **Seats available for allotment through Competent Authority:** The seats available with the competent authority for first round of allotment are only the seats available through lateral entry i.e. $1/10^{\text{th}}$ of the sanctioned intake in each course.

- **100% seats in Government, Non Minority Government Aided Pharmacy colleges & unaided institutions except minority colleges shall be filled through CAP.**
- **50% of the seats available for direct Second year admission in Govt Aided Minority colleges shall be filled through CAP & remaining 50% of the seats shall be filled from minority candidates by the managements of the respective institutes.**
- Seats available with the competent authority for direct Second year admission in un aided minority colleges shall be filled through CAP & at the respective Institutes in a ratio as decided by the respective Minority Institute.

3.1.2 **Seats available with the Institutes:** These seats are classified as follows:

- 3.1.2.1 **Seats remaining vacant (VLE) after CAP Round:** After the centralised allotment process is completed, if any vacancies remain from amongst the total number of seats available with the Competent Authority (i.e. from $1/10^{\text{th}}$ of Sanctioned Intake) either due to non allotment, cancellations or due to non reporting of candidates. Such seats will be permitted to be filled by the respective institute at institute level. These seats are labeled as VLE.

3.1.2.2 Seats remaining vacant (VS) within sanctioned intake: These seats are calculated as below

The available seats for direct admission to second year B. Pharmacy will be calculated as below.

After completion of the entire admission process, the total no. of enrolled candidates in a class should not exceed the new class strength as calculated above. This rule is illustrated with the help of following example:

- 3.2 Reservation of seats :** There will not be any seat reserved for Backward Class category candidates or any other categories such as Physically handicapped, Defence, Girls etc. for direct admission to second year of B. Pharmacy.

4.0 Stages of Centralised Allotment Process

Stage - I - Sale of Application form cum Option form along with Information Brochure

- Information brochure along with specimen Application cum Option form will be available for sale at all the ARCs mentioned in Annexure-III for the aspiring candidates.
- All the information printed in the brochure will also be available on the website www.dte.org.in/dsp07.
- **Price of the information brochure along with specimen Application cum Option form is Rs. 400/- in cash for all the candidates. The ARC Officer shall issue the Receipt of Payment to the candidate on the backside of the Specimen Application cum Option form.**
- Though all the information printed in the brochure will also be available on the website for browsing, downloading and printing, it is mandatory for the candidates to procure the information brochure along with specimen Application cum Option form.

Stage II -Online Submission of Application cum Option Form at ARC

- Aspiring candidates are expected to read the admission rules & information brochure thoroughly.
- The candidate shall fill up the "Specimen Application cum Option Form".
- Aspiring candidates are required to fill the same information as on "Specimen Application cum Option Form" in the web based "Online Application cum Option Form for Admission to Direct Second Year Pharmacy" through the web site www.dte.org.in/dsp07 at any of the ARCs as mentioned in **Annexure - III**.
- *The candidates can also fill the "Online Application cum Option Form for Admission to Direct Second Year Pharmacy" through any computer connected to Internet, either from home or cyber café and take the printout of the Online submitted Application form for confirmation at the ARC*
- Application sent by post/courier will be rejected.
- The web based software of submission of "Online Application cum Option Form for Admission to Direct Second Year Pharmacy" will validate the information filled in by the candidate and generate his/her unique Application ID. The candidate must note down the Application ID & password for further process. Using this Application ID, candidate will be able to login to the online admission system to check status of processing of his/her application form, check position in the merit list etc.
- Candidate must note the Application ID on the reverse side of the Diploma mark sheet for confirmation of submission of the application form at the ARC and any future reference to the information filled in by the candidates on the website.
- The candidate can fill maximum 20.
- After online submission of Application cum Option form, candidate is required to take the printout of the same. The candidate should check the information submitted and should correct the same, if required, himself/herself before confirmation at ARC.
- The candidate should submit only one form. If it is found that the candidate has submitted multiple forms, his/ her candidature shall be cancelled.

Stage III – Confirmation of Submission of Online Application cum Option Form at ARC

- All the candidates who have submitted “Online Application cum Option Form for Admission to Direct Second Year Pharmacy” are required to confirm the submission of application form at any convenient ARCs by producing the duly signed copy of the online Application cum Option Form along with the attested Xerox copies (or Xerox copies with originals) of the required supporting documents enlisted in the online form.
- ARC officer will do the technical and administrative scrutiny of the online submitted Application cum Option form along with the required documents. ARC Officer will confirm whether the candidate has correctly filled the online application form and attached the required documents or not. If the ARC officer finds that the supporting documents are not enough to claim for a valid candidature then the submitted application form will not be accepted for any further processing. If ARC officer finds any correction in the submitted application form then the candidate has to correct it only through his/her login then it will be confirmed by ARC Officer. The candidate shall be responsible for his/her particulars.
- ARC officer shall confirm the “Online Application cum Option Form for Admission to Direct Second Year Pharmacy” and will print 2 copies of the Receipt-cum-acknowledgement letter. The candidate and ARC officer shall sign on both the copies of the Receipt-cum-acknowledgement letter and ARC Officer shall issue one copy to the candidate.

Stage IV – Publication of merit list on website

- The merit list shall be available on <http://www.dte.org.in/dsp07>
- There will not be any direct communication to the candidate.

Stage V – Display of Allotment and Reporting to the institute

- The allotment list shall be published on <http://www.dte.org.in/dsp07>
- The facility to view the allotment shall also be available at ARC.
- There will not be any direct communication to the candidate.
- The candidate will report at the institute where the seat is allotted along with the necessary documents and fees as prescribed by the Shikshan Shulka Samiti.

Stage VI : Confirmation of the admission

- Candidates will confirm the admission at the institute where the seat is allotted by producing the necessary documents and fees as prescribed by the Shikshan Shulka Samiti as per the schedule notified.
- The respective institute will update the confirmation of the candidate’s admission on DTE website through their institute login as per the schedule notified.
- It is the responsibility of the respective principal of the institute to verify the necessary supporting documents of the candidates and accordingly do the confirmation of the candidate’s admission on DTE web site. It is essential to produce the required supporting documents (as entered on DTE web site) of these candidates at the time of merit list approval.

5.0 Documents required to be submitted at the time of confirmation of Application cum Option form at the ARC :

All Candidates are required to submit the attested xerox copies of the following documents at the time of confirmation of Application cum Option form at the ARC.

- (a) Institute (Diploma Course in Pharmacy) leaving Certificate.
- (b) Statement of marks obtained at the qualifying examination (Final year of Diploma Course in Pharmacy) for each attempt.
- (c) Statement of marks obtained at the First year of qualifying examination (Diploma Course in Pharmacy).
- (d) Statement of marks obtained at HSC or its equivalent examination.
- (e) Statement of marks obtained at SSC or its equivalent examination

Candidate claiming admission under Rule 2.2 (2), (3) & (4) of table are also required to produce the additional documents mentioned below as per their claims

- **For candidates seeking admission under Rule 2.2 (Type B)**
Attested Xerox copy of Domicile certificate of Maharashtra State in respect of the candidate or his / her father / mother or Husband clearly indicating place of permanent residence of the candidate himself/herself or candidate's father or mother or husband. Domicile Certificate issuing Authority is Metropolitan Magistrate for Greater Mumbai / Suburban Mumbai and Executive Magistrate for the rest of the region.
- **For candidates seeking admission under Rule 2.2 (Type C and Type D)**
Attested Xerox copy of Transfer order showing the date of transfer of candidate's parent, along with joining certificate from the Head of the office.

All these documents are required to be verified with the original documents by the admission authority when the candidate reports to the institute for confirmation of admission after obtaining the allotment. No admission will be confirmed unless all the original documents are submitted for verification.

6.0 Assignment of Merit Number :**6.1 Merit number :**

- The admission shall be offered strictly on the basis of *inter se* merit of the candidates.
- *Inter se* merit shall be determined on the basis of marks obtained at the final year or final semester / semesters of Diploma course in Pharmacy examination on the basis of which the first class has been awarded by the examining authority. **In case of grades, index, credits etc. a certified copy of the method for conversion into equivalent marks declared by the relevant examination authority should be attached with the application.**

6.2 Relative merit in case of tie :

In case of candidates securing equal number of marks, their relative *inter se* merit shall be determined in the following order :

- (a) A candidate securing higher aggregate marks in First Year Diploma Course in Pharmacy
- (b) A candidate passing the HSC (Std. XII) examination with higher total marks in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Mathematics (whichever is maximum amongst Biology/Mathematics).
- (c) A candidate passing the SSC (Std. X) examination with higher marks out of 150 in Science.
- (d) A candidate securing higher aggregate marks in HSC (Std. XII) examination.
- (e) An older candidate shall be preferred over a younger candidate.

State level Merit list of eligible candidates will be prepared and displayed on the DTE website as per the schedule.

7.0 Admission Rounds:

Admission rounds as shown below shall be carried out.

- **Centralised Direct Allotment Round** for all the seats available for CAP. (ref. 7.1)
- Admission Round at the respective **Institute level** by counselling for the seats remaining vacant after CAP round in Govt., Govt. aided, Govt aided University managed Institute / Departments. (ref. 7.2)
- Admission Round at the respective **Institute level** for the seats remaining vacant after CAP round in **Unaided Institutes**. (ref. 7.3)

7.1 Centralised Direct Allotment Round - CAP :

One round of admission for Maharashtra State candidates will be carried out by direct allotment method through Centralised allotment process for the seats available for CAP. In this round, the allotment is made as per the State merit number for the seats available for the course and as per the logic specified in admission rule 7.1.1.

General Notes:

- Allotment will be carried out as per the inter se Merit, options given by the candidate in the Option form and No. of seats available at that point of time.
- Allotment against the first available option in the order of options mentioned in the option form is retained as final allotment.
- The allotment will be displayed on Internet at the web site <http://www.dte.org.in/dsp07>. The allotment list shows the seat secured by the candidate in the final allotment.
- **No Personal communication / allotment letters in this regard will be issued.**

7.1.1 Logic for allotment:

As per the calculation of seats given by rules 3.1, total number of seats available for admission will be calculated and allotment of seats will be done as per inter se merit, options given by the candidate in the Option form and No. of seats available at that point of time.

7.1.2 Reporting after allotment:

- After the display of allotment list, candidate should report to the respective Institutes where he/she has been allotted a seat within no. of days as specified in the schedule from the date of display of allotment list.
- Candidates should report to the concerned institute with all original certificates needed to substantiate the claims made in the application form regarding eligibility.
- If a candidate fails to substantiate the claims made at the time of submitting the application form by submitting the necessary original documents within the reporting time, the candidate forfeits the claim on the allotted seat.
- If a candidate is unable to produce original certificates at the time of admission on account of admission already secured to some other institution, he or she shall produce a certificate from the head of the institution where he/she has already taken admission indicating that he/she has been admitted to a particular course in that institution on a particular date and hence original certificates have been retained in that institution. The candidate shall produce the attested copies of the certificates duly attested by the Head of the concerned institution. Such candidates shall be required to pay the fees immediately at the time of admission and such candidates shall be permitted to submit the required original certificates within 4 working days after the date of payment of fees.
- After scrutiny of original documents, the candidate will have to pay prescribed fees immediately in the **form as prescribed by the concerned institute** and secure the admission offered.
- If candidate fails to pay the prescribed fees within the reporting time, the candidate forfeits the claim on the allotted seat immediately.
- If a candidate is offered admission, his or her original Institute Leaving Certificate (after qualifying examination) will be retained by the concerned Institute. These original certificates will not be returned to any candidate once admitted to a course at the institute unless the candidate cancels

his/her admission. All other certificates will be verified by the Institute at the time of admission & returned to the candidate.

7.2 Admission Round at the Institute level by counselling for seats remaining vacant after CAP Round in Govt., Govt. aided, Govt. aided University managed Institutes and University Departments:

The seats in only Govt., Govt. aided, Govt. aided University managed Institutes and University Departments remaining vacant after the allotment round of CAP will be filled by the Principal /Director of the respective institutes at the Institute level. This round will be conducted by counselling.

Eligible candidates : All the candidates as per their *inter se* merit.

The eligible candidate has to approach to the Principals of the respective institutions for the admission.

Seats available: The seats within sanctioned intake available for this admission round are the seats remaining vacant at the end of allotment round due to :

- Non allotment
- Non reporting of allotted candidates
- Cancellation of admission by allotted and reported candidates before the start of this admission round.

General notes:

- The vacancy position and the detailed schedule will be available at the respective institutes.
- Any seat from that institute (to which a candidate may have been admitted in earlier rounds) falling vacant due to change in admission i.e. admission to a different seat in the current round, shall be made available to the next candidate in merit.
- Candidates admitted in the Govt. / Govt. aided / Govt. aided University managed colleges / University Departments through direct allotment round are not required to pay the fees on securing admissions in this round. Such candidates have to produce original fees receipt of Allotment Round admission.
- For the candidate who has secured admission in Unaided Institution in the direct allotment round and gets admission to the Govt. / Govt. aided / Govt. aided University managed colleges / University Departments in this round has to confirm the admission by paying requisite fees. Candidate has to cancel his/ her earlier admission at his/ her own risk and cost.

7.3 Seats remaining vacant in Unaided institutions after CAP round :

The management of the un-aided institutions have to process the admissions for the vacancies after the CAP allotment as per the guidelines given in annexure-I.

8.0 Fees, Concessions, cancellations and refund :

8.1 Fees prescribed:

Note :

- Candidates claiming for fee concession under reservation category shall produce the Caste Certificate from Executive Magistrate. Candidates claiming for fee concession under VJ, NT-B, NT-C, NT-D, SBC, OBC category shall also produce Non creamy layer certificate valid upto 31st March 2008.
- No additional fees other than the University Fees as specified by the University and Hostel Fees in case of candidates opting for hostel accommodation shall be charged at institute level from the candidates.

8.2 Concession in tuition and other fees:

All the schemes given below, regarding concession in tuition & other fees shall be available to candidates belonging to Maharashtra State only subject to the fulfillment of the eligibility criteria specified by respective authorities offering such concession in fees from time to time.

8.2.1 E.B.C. Concession:

Candidates claiming concessions for Economically Backward Class (E.B.C.) shall produce a certificate from the Executive Magistrate to the effect that the candidate belongs to EBC category (**The income limit is revised to Rs.1Lakh/Annum**) at the time of admission. They shall, on admission, also submit an application in the prescribed form for being granted the concession of free education, to the appropriate authorities through the college to which they are admitted within one month from the actual date of joining of college or as may be required. The students shall note that applications received after the due date may not be considered and in that case, they will have to pay the necessary fees.

The concessions in tuition fee at the time of admission will be given only for Government, University Managed and Government-Aided Institutions.

EBC Candidates are required to pay 50% of the tuition fees, exam and other fees at the time of confirming admission secured through CAP rounds in Unaided Institutes. The remaining 50% of tuition fees of such candidates will be reimbursed by the concerned department to the institute.

Note: - As per GR No: TEM-2006/ (353/06)/TE-1, dated 21 March 2007, the income limit for E.B.C. candidates is revised to Rs.1Lakh/Annum.

8.2.2 Concession in fees for Backward Class Category Candidates (belonging to Maharashtra State only) in Unaided Private Institutes:

- **For SC/ST/VJ DT NT(A)/NT(B)/NT(C)/NT(D)/SBC/OBC category candidates**

As per the various circulars from the Social and Tribal Welfare Departments, Govt. of Maharashtra, Backward Class Category candidates belonging to **SC/ST/VJ-DT NT(A)/ NT(B)/ NT(C)/ NT(D)/ SBC/OBC** categories securing admission to Unaided Institutes **through CAP round** only are eligible for obtaining reimbursement of the fees approved by the Shikshan Shulka Samiti, Mumbai (SSS). However, these candidates will get only that amount of waiver as notified in the circulars issued by the Social Justice and Tribal Welfare Departments from time to time, subject to fulfillment of various norms and conditions laid down by these Departments. Details of the fees concession, amount of waiver, documents needed is as follows:

Note:

- Candidates claiming for fee concession under reservation category shall produce the requisite certificates as specified by the respective Social Justice and Tribal Welfare Departments.
- The Principals/Directors of the Unaided Institutes are required to admit candidates belonging to SC/ST/VJ-DT NT (A)/NT (B)/NT(C)/NT (D)/SBC categories who have secured admission through CAP rounds only, **without accepting fees from the candidates**. The fees of such candidates will be reimbursed by the concerned Social Justice and Tribal Welfare department to the institute.
- Candidates belonging to OBC category are required to pay 50% of the fees approved by SSS at the time of confirming admission secured through CAP rounds in Unaided Institutes. The remaining 50% fees of such candidates will be reimbursed by the concerned Social Justice and Tribal Welfare department to the institute.
- Strict action will be taken by the State govt. against the institutes violating these norms.

8.3 Caution Money: Caution money deposits will be forfeited to Government and Government aided institutions and will be transferred to Students welfare funds, if it is not claimed in writing within three financial years after the student actually leaves the institution or within three financial years after the date of successful completion of the course, whichever is earlier.

8.4 Refund of Tuition, Development and Other fees after cancellation of admission secured through CAP round, in Institute level round(s) and in Vacancy Round(s) of admissions in Government, Aided, University departments etc. and Unaided Institutes:

- The candidate who has been provisionally admitted may cancel admission by submitting an application in duplicate, in the prescribed pro forma - O and may request for refund of fees. The refund of fees as applicable shall be made in due course. It is made clear that such application for cancellation will be considered if and only if the admission is confirmed by paying the prescribed tuition fee and other fees in full and by submitting the original documents. Refund shall be made after deduction of the cancellation charges as shown below:

- In the event of a student/ candidate withdrawing before the starting of the course, the wait-listed candidates should be given admissions against the vacant seat. The entire fee collected from the student, after a deduction of the processing fee of **not more than Rs.1000/-** (Rupees one thousand only) shall be refunded and returned by the Institution/ University to the student/candidate withdrawing from the programme.
- Should a student leave after joining the course and if the seat consequently falling vacant has been filled by another candidate by the last date of admission, the Institution must return the fee collected with proportionate deductions of monthly fee and proportionate hostel rent, where applicable.

9.0 Miscellaneous:

- (a) **The medium of instruction for B. Pharmacy course is English.**
- (b) The candidates admitted to a course in Pharmacy will have to produce the Eligibility Certificate from the University to which the College is affiliated. If candidate fails to produce eligibility certificate his / her admission will be cancelled at any stage.
- (c) **Candidate once admitted directly to the second year of B. Pharmacy any college shall not be eligible for transfer to any other institution during the same academic year.**
- (d) Head of the institution may refer the candidate to the appropriate medical authority for ascertaining the physical fitness of the candidate to undergo the requirements of the course.
- (e) Head of the institution may verify the antecedents of the candidate through the appropriate police authority.

10.0 Hostel accommodation:

Accommodation in hostel is not guaranteed. Candidates are advised to verify personally whether the hostel accommodation is available or not by contacting Principals of concerned colleges. Hostel fees should also be ascertained by the candidates from the Principals before taking admission.

11.0 Conduct and discipline:

- Notwithstanding anything contained in these Rules, if the State Government, after consultation with the Vice-Chancellor of the University / Chairman of Board, and after making such enquiry as it may deem fit, is of the opinion that there were serious malpractice or unfair means used at any qualifying examination of University or Board, such as intensive copying, the State Government may, by order, prescribed additional test or examination for the students who have appeared at that examination and who seek direct admission to second year of the Pharmacy colleges.
- Students while studying in any Pharmacy college, if found indulging in antinational activities contrary to the provisions of Acts and Laws enforced by Government, any activity contrary to the rules of discipline will be liable to be expelled from the college without any notice by the Principal of the concerned college.
- If any of the statement made in application form or any information supplied by the candidate in connection with his / her admission is later on, at any time, found to be false or incorrect, his/her admission will be cancelled, fee forfeited and he / she may be expelled from the college by the principal or / and prosecuted, if deemed necessary. An appeal against the order of expulsion, however, may be preferred within 8 days from the date of letter of expulsion, to the Director of Technical Education whose decision in such cases will be final.
- **Action against ragging: Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act 1999 which is in effect from 15th May 1999 has the following provisions for Action against Ragging.**
 - a) Ragging within or outside of any educational institution is prohibited,
 - b) Whosoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets, or propagates ragging within or outside any educational institution shall, on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term up to 2 years and / or penalty which may extend to ten thousand rupees.

- c) Any student convicted of an offence of ragging shall be dismissed from the educational institution and such student shall not be admitted in any other educational institution for a period of five years from the date of order of such dismissal.
- d) Whenever any student or, as the case may be, the parent or guardian or a teacher of an educational institution complains, in writing, of ragging to the head of the educational institution, the head of the educational institution shall, without prejudice to the foregoing provisions, within seven days of the receipt of the complaint, enquire into the matter mentioned in the complaint and if, prima facie, it is found true, suspend the student who is accused of the offence, and shall, immediately forward the complaint to the police station having jurisdiction over the area in which the educational institution is situated, for further action. Where, on enquiry by the head of the educational institution, it is found that there is no substance, prima facie, in the complaint received, he /she shall intimate the fact, in writing, to the complainant. The decision of the head of the educational institution shall be final.
- e) If the head of the educational institution fails or neglects to act in the manner specified in section "d" above when a complaint of ragging is made, such person shall be deemed to have abetted the offence and shall, on conviction, be punished as provided for in section "b" above.

12.0 Legal jurisdiction: All disputes pertaining to the admission shall fall within the jurisdiction of Mumbai High Court, bench at Mumbai only. The Competent Authority shall be the legal person in whose name the Government of Maharashtra may sue or may be sued.

13.0 Undertaking:

All candidates who have applied for admission shall be deemed to have submitted the following undertaking :

I have read all the Rules of Admission and after understanding these rules thoroughly, I have filled in the application form for admission for the current year.

The information given by me in my application is true to the best of my knowledge and belief. I understand that if any of the statements made by me in the application form or any information supplied by me in connection with my admission is later on at any time, found to be false or incorrect, my admission will be cancelled, fees forfeited and I may be expelled from the college by the Principal.

- a) I have not been debarred from appearing at any examination held by any Government constituted or Statutory examination authority in India.
- b) I fully understand that the allotment of a course will be made to me depending on my *inter se* merit, order of Preference given by me and the number of seats available at that point of time in a stage.
- c) I understand that no document after the last date of submission will be entertained for the purpose of claims or concessions etc. in connection with my admission unless otherwise mentioned in the rules.
- d) I am fully aware that the Competent Authority or its representative will not make any correspondence with me regarding admission. I am also aware that it is entirely my responsibility to see the nonfictions in the newspaper and notices on the notice boards of concerned ARCs.
- e) I am aware that any rule imposed by the University such as 'imposing limits on the number of attempts permissible to pass any examination' shall be binding on me.
- f) I hereby agree to conform to any Rules, Acts and Laws enforced by Government and I hereby undertake that, I will do nothing either inside or outside the college which may result in disciplinary action against me under these rules, acts and laws referred to.

- g) I fully understand that the Principal of the college where I would be admitted, has a right to expel me from the college for any infringement of the rules of conduct and discipline prescribed by the college or University or Government and the undertaking given above.
- h) **Condition of minimum attendance** : I am fully aware that, I will not be allowed to appear for the examination if I do not attend minimum 75 per cent classes of theory, practical, drawing etc. I am also aware that I will not be allowed to appear for the examination, if I fail to submit satisfactorily all the assignments, jobs, journals, drawings, reports as specified by the University within stipulated time limit.

ANNEXURE-I**Guidelines for the Admission Process to be carried out by Unaided Institutes****1.0 Admissions to Allotment Round allottees for the institute**

Admission authority in the institute shall follow the procedure mentioned under rule no. 7.1.2 and should verify the original documents as mentioned in rule no. 5.0 while confirming the admission of candidates who have been allotted seat through Centralised Allotment Process.

2.0 Admission to seats remaining vacant after admitting Allotment Round allottees**Eligible candidates:**

All candidates eligible for the admission as per the eligibility mentioned in Rule no. 2.0.

Seats available: Vacant seats within **New class strength** for the course sanctioned intake. (As per rule 3.1.2.2)

Guidelines for the admission process :

- The Principals of the respective Un aided Pharmacy Colleges shall invite applications for all the vacant seats available by giving publicity **at least in one of the leading newspapers** clearly mentioning the course wise vacancies. Institutes are required to mention the name of newspaper in which vacancy position will be notified in their prospectus/brochure. Vacancies are also to be displayed on the notice board of the Institute. Detailed schedule of the admission process is also to be displayed.
- Aspiring candidates fulfilling the eligibility criteria shall apply directly to the Principal of the respective colleges for admissions. These admissions will be made in a transparent manner and strictly as per the **merit of the candidates** who have applied to the institute.
- Candidates not eligible for admission under Rule 2.2 shall also be considered for admission against the vacant seats, if any. Such candidates will be considered only after all the applicants eligible under rule 2.2 have been offered admission.
- At the end of admission process, the Principal of the institute has to submit the branch wise list of admitted candidates to the Joint Director of respective region within 7 calendar days from the last date for completion of admission process for the academic year 2007-08 as per the schedule.
- The regional office of the Joint Director of Technical Education verifies the supporting documents and forwards the admitted candidate list to the Director, Technical Education with the Remarks of Joint Director for final approval
- The DTE accords the final approval to the list of admitted candidates. It is binding on all the Universities to grant enrollment only for the students on approved list. Admission shall be subject to final Approval by the Directorate of Technical Education, M.S., Mumbai.

Any other matter not specifically covered by these rules shall be decided by the Director of Technical Education and his decision will be final.

जर विद्यार्थी इयत्ता १२वी विज्ञान परिक्षा (पदार्थविज्ञान, रसायनशास्त्र, गणित, जीवशास्त्र विषय घेउन उत्तीर्ण व औषधनिर्माणशास्त्र पदविका अभ्यासक्रम प्रथमश्रेणीत उत्तीर्ण झाला असेल असेच उमेदवार या प्रवेश प्रक्रियेसाठी पात्र ठरतात. सर्व पात्र विद्यार्थ्यांची गुणवत्ता यादी त्यांनी मिळविलेल्या पदविकेच्या शेवटच्या वर्षातील प्राप्त गुणांवर आधारीत असते. राज्यस्तरीय गुणवत्ता यादी तयार करुन विद्यार्थांस गुणवत्ता क्रमांक दिला जातो. यामुळे गुणवत्ता यादीतील विद्यार्थांस विकल्प देण्यास मदत होते.

४) ऑप्लिकेशन - कम - ऑप्शन फॉर्म

हा अर्ज ऑनलाईन पध्दतीने इंटरनेटच्या माध्यमातून कोणत्याही संगणकावर भरता येतो. ऑनलाईन पध्दतीने प्रत्येक विद्यार्थांस विशिष्ट अर्ज क्रमांक (Application ID) दिला जातो व त्याद्वारे विद्यार्थानी अर्ज भरावयाचा असतो. या अर्जामध्ये विद्यार्थ्यांची वैयक्तिक माहिती, शैक्षणिक माहिती तसेच विकल्प मागविले जातात. परंतु विद्यार्थांस ऑप्लिकेशन फॉर्म रिसिप्ट सेंटर (एआरसी) मध्ये जाऊन सर्व संबंधित प्रमाणपत्रांची पडताळणी करुन स्वतःचा अर्ज व विकल्प अर्ज निश्चित करणे अत्यंत आवश्यक आहे. प्रवेश व विकल्प अर्ज निश्चित करणे म्हणजे प्रमाणपत्रांची पडताळणी केल्यानंतर एआरसीमधील संगणकावर संबंधित अधिका-याने अर्ज प्राप्त झाल्याची नोंद करणे आवश्यक आहे. याबाबत विद्यार्थ्यांनी अर्जस्विकृती पावती प्राप्त करुन घ्यावी व त्याची स्वतः नोंद झाल्याची खात्री स्वतःचा लॉगिन आयडी वापरुन करुन घ्यावी. काही विद्यार्थी स्वतः प्रिंट आऊट काढून फक्त एआरसीचा शिक्का आणतात त्यामुळे याची संगणकात कोठेही नोंद घेतली जात नाही व असे विद्यार्थी प्रवेशापासून वंचित राहातात. आपले नांव

५) अलॉटमेंट लॉजिक

➤ केंद्रिभूत प्रवेश फेरीमध्ये विद्यार्थ्यांकडून अर्ज भरते वेळी विकल्प (ऑप्शन फॉर्म) अर्ज घेतले जातात. विद्यार्थ्यांची गुणवत्ता, दिलेले विकल्प व उपलब्ध जागा यानुसार विद्यार्थ्यांना अलॉटमेंट म्हणजेच संस्था व अभ्यासक्रम दिला जातो.

विकल्प म्हणजे काय?

९२ हा अंक फार्मसी या अभ्यासक्रमाकरिता आहे.

अशाच पध्दतीने महाराष्ट्रातील सर्व संस्थांतील सर्व अभ्यासक्रमांना क्रमांक दिलेले आहेत. ते सर्व क्रमांक माहिती पुस्तकात चॉईस कोड या कॉलम मध्ये नमूद केलेले आहे.

केंद्रिभूत प्रवेश फेरीसाठी एकूण २० विकल्प उपलब्ध असून त्यापैकी कमीत कमी एक व जास्तीतजास्त २० विकल्प विद्यार्थी लिहू शकतात. हे विकल्प देताना विद्यार्थ्यांनी विकल्पांचे प्राधान्य क्रमांक ठरवावेत.

ऑप्शन फॉर्म भरत असताना विद्यार्थ्यांना मार्गदर्शन म्हणून काही मुद्दे:-

- स्वतःचा गुणवत्ता क्रमांक गुणवत्ता यादीत कितवा आहे ते पहावे.
