1.0 General:

These Rules and Information given herein shall be applicable for Admission to Second Year of four-year full time Degree Course in Pharmacy in.

- **All Government Institutes in Maharashtra State.**
- **All Government Aided Institutes in Maharashtra State.**
- **All University Managed Pharmacy Institutes in Maharashtra State.**
- **University Departments.**
- **All Unaided Colleges in Maharashtra State.**

These Rules also Incorporate the guidelines for the Unaided Institutes for carrying out the Direct Second Year Degree Pharmacy Admissions for the seats remaining vacant after the Completion of Centralised Allotment Process (**Ref. Annexure-1**).

1.2 Definitions:

- **'State Government'** means the **Government of Maharashtra.**
- **'Director'** means the **Director of Technical Education, Maharashtra State.**

- '**Competent Authority**' means the Authority Appointed by the Government to invite applications, and Implement the Admission Procedure as prescribed in the Brochure. **Director of Technical Education** is the Competent Authority.
- '**Representative of the Competent Authority**' means an officer appointed to assist Competent Authority for smooth conduct of Admission Process as per the Directives of the Competent Authority.
- Application form Receipt Center (**ARC**) is an Institution/Center where a Candidate can fill the Specimen Application form, submit it and upload it.
- '**College**' or '**Institution**' means Institution duly Approved by the **AICTE** and **Government of Maharashtra** to Impart Education in Pharmaceutical Sciences leading to Degree in Pharmacy.
- **PCI** means **Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi**.
- "**Sanctioned Intake**", means the course wise number of seats Sanctioned by the **A.I.C.T.E.** and approved by the **Government of Maharashtra**.
- "**Course**" means four year Degree Course/Programme in Pharmacy.
- "**MSBTE**" means **Maharashtra State Board of Technical Education**.
- "**Diploma**" means Diploma awarded by the **Maharashtra State Board of Technical Education**, or Equivalent thereto as per ER-91 Regulations, which will be Considered as "Qualifying Examination" or Diploma awarded by **AICTE** approved Autonomous Polytechnics in **Maharashtra state**.
- "**Aided College/Institution**" means Institution run by Private Management by receiving grant-in-aid" from **State Government** or **Central Government**.
- '**University Managed Pharmacy College/Institute**' means **Pharmacy College/Institute** run by a Particular University.
- '**University Department**' means a Department of University, which offers four year Degree Programme in Pharmacy.
- '**Un-aided institute**' means Institution run by Private Management without receiving grant-in-aid from **State Government** or **Central Government**.
- "**Management**" means the Managing Body of Registered Trust or Society Responsible for Managing the **Pharmacy College/Institute**.
- '**Inter se merit**' means the order of Merit as Defined by **Maharashtra State** Merit List.
- '**Candidate**' means an applicant who desires to seek Admission to Second Year of four year Degree Course in Pharmacy in **Maharashtra State** by submitting the prescribed application form.

2.0 Eligibility

2.1 Educational Qualification:

The Candidate must be Indian National and should have passed.

- HSC Examination with Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Mathematics (or both) from **Board of Higher Secondary Examination, Maharashtra State**. Candidates who have not offered either Mathematics or Biology at XII Std Examination shall have to appear and pass in the particular subject at the Examination of XII std Conducted by the Higher Secondary Board in **Maharashtra State**.

AND

- The Candidate should have passed in **First class /First class with condonation**, post HSC Diploma Course in Pharmacy (as per ER-91 Regulations of PCI) from an Institution **Approved by AICTE** and of
 - the **Maharashtra State Board of Technical Education (MSBTE)**

OR

 - any other Recognized Diploma¹ Equivalent to the Diploma awarded by the **Maharashtra State Board of Technical Education (MSBTE)** with English as the medium of instruction at Diploma Level.

¹ Such candidates shall produce Equivalence certificate from MSBTE, 4th floor, Govt. Polytechnic Building, 49, Kherwadi, Ali Yavar Jung Marg, Bandra (E), Mumbai- 400 051 (www.msbtte.com) at the time of confirmation of application form at ARC.

OR

- any other **AICTE** approved Institution which has been granted Academic Autonomy by the **Government of Maharashtra** or **University in the State of Maharashtra**.

2.2 Criteria for Eligibility as Maharashtra State Candidate:

A Candidate is considered Eligible for Admission to direct Second Year of Pharmacy through **CAP** subject to Fulfillment of any one of the Eligibility Criteria as listed in the following table.

2.3 General Notes on Eligibility:

- Candidate Passing SSC (Std. X)/ HSC (Std. XII) / any other Equivalent Examination **and / or** Diploma Course in Pharmacy Examination as Specified in rule 2.1 from a Recognized Institution situated outside the State of Maharashtra.

AND

Not satisfying any of the Conditions stated in Sr. No. 2, 3, 4 (i.e. Type B,C,D) above as regards to parent's status are not Eligible for Admission through **CAP** and also in **Govt./Govt. Aided / Govt. Aided University managed Institutes / University Departments** for any subsequent Institute level rounds. However, these Candidates are Eligible for the seats remaining vacant after Admitting Maharashtra Candidates in the Unaided Institutes.

- If the University has prescribed any Additional conditions for Eligibility of First Class Diploma Holders to Degree Course in Pharmacy, the same also shall be Applicable for Admission to a College Affiliated to that University.
- Admission of any Candidate made at the Institution shall be Provisional, subject to the acceptance / production of Eligibility Certificate from the concerned University and the final approval to the merit list of second year Degree Pharmacy Course by the **Director of Technical Education, Maharashtra State**, Mumbai. If Candidate fails to get Eligibility, his Admission may be cancelled at any stage.
- Candidates admitted to Direct Second Year B. Pharmacy Class will have to appear and pass in the subject of Industrial Psychology prescribed in F.Y. B. Pharmacy syllabus in addition to producing passing Certificate in Mathematics / Biology at XII Std Examination of Higher Secondary Board in Maharashtra State, if he / she has not offered / passed in any / both the subjects. Failing to production of this Certificate, the student will not be promoted to third year Degree in Pharmacy.
- Candidates passing Diploma in Pharmacy from Institution **not approved by AICTE/PCI** are not Eligible and therefore shall not have any claim on Admission.

3.0 Allocation and Reservation of Seats:

3.1 Seats Available for Admission to Direct Second Year: These Seats are Classified as follows:

- The seats available with the Competent Authority for the **CAP** are as follows
 - i. Lateral Entry Seats = LE = $1/10^{\text{th}} \times \text{SI}$
 - ii. Seats Remaining Vacant within Sanctioned Intake (VS)

* Transfer to the Course shall be Effected after Accomodating Repeaters, to such an extent if and only if the CS after Calculations works out to be less than to SI after declaration of result.

3.1.1 Seats Available for Admission through Competent Authority:

100% of the seats available with the competent authority in **Government, Government Aided Pharmacy Colleges & Unaided Institutions** except unaided Minority Colleges shall be filled through **CAP**.

Seats available with the Competent Authority for Admission to Direct Second Year in Unaided Minority Colleges shall be filled through **CAP** & at the Respective Minority Institutes in a ratio as communicated by the Respective Minority Institute.

3.1.2 Seats Available with the Institutes:

Seats Remaining Vacant after CAP Rounds: After Completion of the **CAP** Rounds, if any Vacancy remain from amongst the total number of seats available with the Competent Authority either due to Non Allotment, Cancellations or due to non reporting of Candidates, will be permitted to be filled by the Respective Institutes with prior approval from the **DTE** subject to the condition that the class strength will not exceed **NCS** confirmed by the Competent Authority.

Minority Seats: The Unaided Minority Institute can Admit the Minority Candidate as per the guidelines given in **Annexure III**.

3.2 Reservation of Seats:

There will not be any seats reserved for Backward Class Category Candidates or any other Categories such as Physically Handicapped, Defence, Girls etc. for Admission to Direct Second year of Pharmacy.

4.0 Assignment of Merit Number:

4.1 Merit Number:

- The Admission shall be offered strictly on the basis of *inter se* Merit of the Candidates.
- *Inter se* Merit shall be determined on the basis of marks obtained at the final year or final Semester / Semesters of Diploma Course in Pharmacy Examination on the basis of which the first class has been awarded by the Examining Authority. **In case of Grades, Index, Credits etc. a Certified copy of the Method for Conversion into Equivalent marks declared by the Relevant Examination Authority should be Attached with the Application.**

4.2 Relative Merit in case of Tie:

In case of Candidates securing Equal number of marks, their relative *inter se* merit shall be determined in the following order :

- (a) A Candidate securing higher aggregate marks in First Year Diploma Course in Pharmacy.
- (b) A Candidate passing the HSC (Std. XII) Examination with Higher total marks in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Mathematics (whichever is maximum amongst Biology/Mathematics).
- (c) A Candidate passing the SSC (Std. X) Examination with Higher marks out of 150 in Science.
- (d) A Candidate securing Higher Aggregate marks in HSC (Std. XII) Examination.
- (e) An Older Candidate shall be preferred over a Younger Candidate.

State level Merit list of Eligible Candidates will be prepared and displayed on the DTE website as per the schedule.

5.0 Admission Rounds:

For the Academic Year 2009-10, the Competent Authority shall conduct total Three (3) rounds of Centralized Admission.

Summary of "Rules of Reporting" in CAP is as follows:

5.1. CAP Rounds I/II/III by Allotment:**5.1.1 CAP Rounds I /II/III: Direct Allotment:****General Notes:**

- Allotment will be carried out as per Rule No. 5.1.2.
- Allotment against the first available option in the order of options mentioned in the option form is retained as final Allotment.
- The Allotment will be displayed on Internet at the web site <http://www.dte.org.in/dsp09>. The Allotment list shows the seat secured by the Candidate in the final Allotment.
- No Personal Communication / Allotment letters in this regard will be issued.**

5.1.2 Logic for Allotment:

As per the calculation of seats given by rules 3.1, total number of seats available for Admission will be calculated and Allotment of seats will be done as per inter se merit, options given by the Candidate in the Option form and No. of seats available at that point of time.

6.0 Fees, Concessions, Cancellations and Refund:**6.1 Fees Prescribed in Govt., Govt. Aided, University Managed Pharmacy Colleges, University Departments:****Tuition Fee :**

- For Open Category Candidates:** The Annual Tuition, development and other fees for Govt., Govt. Aided, Govt. Aided University managed Pharmacy Colleges and University Departments is as indicated below: **Tuition fee: Rs. 8000/-**
- For SC/ST/VJ-NT(A)/NT-(B)/NT-(C) / NT-(D)/ SBC /OBC Category Candidates :** No tuition fee for Admission in Govt./ Govt. Aided / Govt aided University Managed Pharmacy Colleges and University Departments.

6.2 Fees Prescribed in Unaided Pharmacy Colleges:

The Interim fee structure for unaided Pharmacy Colleges Approved by the **Shikshan Shulka Samiti** will be made Available on <http://www.dte.org.in/dsp09>. Unaided Pharmacy Colleges may have submitted their proposals for revision in fees to **Shikshan Shulka Samiti**. The revision in the fees if any, by the **Shikshan Shulka Samiti** will be binding on the students who will be admitted in the year 2009-10 and the students taking Admission in these Institutes will have to pay the fees Accordingly.

6.3 University Fees:

Candidates shall be required to pay fees as prescribed by the concerned University from time to time.

6.4 Caution Money Deposits:

Caution Money Deposits received from the students shall be refunded after successful completion of the course or after canceling the Admission. Unless there is any recovery, no deduction shall be made from the Caution Money Deposit. However, the amount of Caution Money Deposit shall be transferred to Students Aid Fund in case of Un-Aided Colleges and Credited to Government in case of Government and Government-Aided College, if Candidate does not apply for refund, within three complete financial years after the student actually leaves the Institution; or, within three complete financial years after the date of successful completion of the course, whichever is earlier.

6.5 Refund of Tuition, Development and Other Fees after Cancellation of Admission secured through CAP round, in Institute Level round(s) and Vacancy Round(s) of Admissions in Government, Aided, University Departments etc. and Unaided Institutes:

The Candidate who has been Provisionally admitted may cancel Admission by submitting an application in duplicate, in the prescribed pro forma - O and may request for refund of fees. The refund of fees as applicable shall be made in due course. It is made clear that such application for cancellation will be considered if and only if the Admission is confirmed by paying the prescribed tuition fee and other fees in full and by submitting the original documents. Refund shall be made after deduction of the cancellation charges as shown below:

Note:

1. Amount of Security/Caution Money Deposit is to be refunded entirely to Candidate.
2. * For the calculation of amount on the pro-rata basis, one month shall be treated as one unit e.g. if the candidate cancels the admission on third day after start of the Academic session and the seat is filled on/before the cutoff date, then cancellation amount will be, total fees/12 or Rs. 1000/-, whichever is higher.

6.6 Concession in Tuition and Other fees:

All the schemes given below, regarding concession in tuition & other fees shall be available to candidates belonging to Maharashtra State only subject to the fulfillment of the Eligibility Criteria specified by Respective Authorities offering such concession in fees from time to time.

6.6.1 E.B.C. Concession:

Candidates Claiming concessions for Economically Backward Class (E.B.C.) shall produce a Certificate from the Executive Magistrate to the effect that the Candidate belongs to EBC Category at the time of Admission. They shall, on Admission, also submit an application in the prescribed form for being granted the concession of free Education, to the appropriate authorities through the college to which they are admitted within one month from the actual date of joining of college or as may be required.

The students shall note that applications received after the due date may not be considered and in that case, they will have to pay the necessary fees.

The Concessions in tuition fee at the time of Admission will be given only for Government, University Managed, University Department and Government-Aided Institutions.

The scheme/ mode of Concessions, scheme of loan scholarship (if any) for Eligible EBC candidates, in tuition & other fees in the Un-Aided Institutions will be announced by the State Government.

6.6.2 Concession in fees for Backward Class Category Candidates (belonging to Maharashtra State only) in Unaided Private Institutes: (For SC/ST/VJ DT NT(A)/NT(B)/NT(C)/NT(D)/SBC /OBC Category Candidates)

The scheme/mode of Concessions, scheme of loan scholarship (if any) for Eligible SC/ST/VJ DT NT(A)/NT(B)/NT(C)/NT(D)/SBC /OBC Category Candidates, in Tuition & other fees in the Un-Aided Institutions will be Announced by the State Government.

However, these Candidates will get only that amount of waiver as notified in the Circulars issued by the Social Justice and Tribal Welfare Departments from time to time, subject to Fulfillment of various norms and conditions laid down by these Departments.

Note:

- Candidates claiming for the fee concession under Reservation Category shall produce the requisite Certificates as may be specified by the Respective Social Justice and Tribal Welfare Departments.
- **Strict action will be taken by the State Govt. against the institutes violating these norms.**

6.6.3 Scholarship Scheme for Students Belonging to Minority Communities

Students belonging to **Muslim/ Christian/ Buddhist/ Shikh/ Parsi** community can apply through the admitted Institutes for the 'Merit-cum- Means Based Scholarship Scheme' of **Government of India**.

7.0 Miscellaneous:

- (a) The medium of Instruction is English.
- (b) Candidates admitted to a course in Pharmacy will have to produce the Eligibility Certificate from the University to which the College is Affiliated. If Candidate fails to produce Eligibility Certificate his / her Admission will be cancelled at any stage.
- (c) **Candidate once admitted directly to the second year of a course in any college shall not be Eligible for transfer to any other Institution during the same Academic year.**
- (d) Head of the Institution may refer the Candidate to the appropriate medical authority for ascertaining the physical fitness of the Candidate to undergo the Requirements of the course.

(e) Head of the institution may verify the Antecedents of the Candidate through the appropriate Police Authority.

(f) **Any other matter not specifically covered by these rules shall be decided by the Director of Technical Education and his decision will be final.**

8.0 Hostel Accomodation:

Accommodation in hostels is not guaranteed. Candidates are advised to verify personally whether the hostel accommodation is available or not by contacting Principals of concerned colleges. Hostel fees should also be ascertained by the Candidates from the Principals before taking Admission.

9.0 Conduct and Discipline:

- Not withstanding anything contained in these Rules, if the State Government, after consultation with the Vice-Chancellor of the University / Chairman of Board, and after making such enquiry as it may deem fit, is of the opinion that there were serious malpractice or unfair means used at any Qualifying Examination of University or Board, such as intensive copying, the State Government may, by order, prescribed additional test or Examination for the students who have appeared at that Examination and who seek Direct Admission to second year of the Pharmacy Colleges.
- Students while studying in any Pharmacy College, if found indulging in Antinational Activities contrary to the provisions of Acts and Laws enforced by Government, any activity contrary to the rules of discipline will be liable to be expelled from the College without any notice by the Principal of the concerned College.
- If any of the statement made in application form or any information supplied by the Candidate in connection with his / her admission is later on, at any time, found to be false or incorrect, his/her admission will be cancelled, fee forfeited and he / she may be expelled from the college by the principal or / and prosecuted, if deemed necessary. An appeal against the order of expulsion, however, may be preferred within 8 days from the date of letter of expulsion, to the Director of Technical Education whose decision in such cases will be final.
- **Action Against Ragging: Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act 1999 which is in effect from 15th May 1999 has the following provisions for Action against Ragging.**
 - a) Ragging within or outside of any Educational Institution is Prohibited.
 - b) Whosoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets, or propagates ragging within or outside any Educational Institution shall, on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term up to 2 years and / or penalty which may extend to Ten Thousand Rupees.
 - c) Any student convicted of an offence of ragging shall be dismissed from the Educational Institution and such student shall not be admitted in any other Educational Institution for a period of five years from the date of order of such dismissal.
 - d) Whenever any student or, as the case may be, the Parent or Guardian or a Teacher of an Educational Institution complaints, in writing, of ragging to the head of the Educational Institution, the head of the Educational Institution shall, without prejudice to the foregoing provisions, within seven days of the receipt of the complaint, enquire into the matter mentioned in the complaint and if, prima facie, it is found true, suspend the student who is accused of the offence, and shall, immediately forward the complaint to the police station having jurisdiction over the area in which the Educational Institution is situated, for further action. Where, on enquiry by the head of the Educational Institution, it is found that there is no substance, prima facie, in the complaint received; he /she shall intimate the fact, in writing, to the complainant. The decision of the head of the Educational Institution shall be final.

- e) If the head of the Educational Institution fails or neglects to act in the manner specified in section "d" above when a complaint of ragging is made, such person shall be deemed to have abetted the offence and shall, on conviction, be punished as provided for in section "b" above.

10.0 Legal Jurisdiction:

All disputes pertaining to the Admission shall fall within the Jurisdiction of Mumbai High Court, bench at Mumbai only. The Competent Authority shall be the legal person in whose name the **Government of Maharashtra** may sue or may be sued.

11.0 Undertaking:

All Candidates who have applied for Admission shall be deemed to have submitted the following undertaking :

I have read all the Rules of Admission and after understanding these Rules thoroughly, I have filled in the application form for Admission for the current year.

The information given by me in my application is true to the best of my knowledge and belief. I understand that if any of the statements made by me in the application form or any Information supplied by me in connection with my Admission is later on at any time, found to be false or incorrect, my Admission will be cancelled, fees forfeited and I may be expelled from the College by the Principal.

- a) I have not been Debarred from appearing at any Examination held by any Government constituted or Statutory Examination Authority in India.
- b) I fully understand that the allotment of a course will be made to me depending on my *inter se* merit, order of Preference given by me and the number of seats available at that point of time in a stage.

- f) I hereby agree to conform to any Rules, Acts and Laws enforced by Government and I hereby undertake that, I will do nothing either inside or outside the college which may result in disciplinary action against me under these rules, acts and laws referred to.
- g) I fully understand that the Principal of the college where I would be admitted, has a right to expel me from the college for any infringement of the rules of conduct and discipline prescribed by the college or University or Government and the undertaking given above.
- h) **Condition of Minimum Attendance** : I am fully aware that, I will not be allowed to appear for the examination if I do not attend minimum 75% classes of theory, practical, drawing etc. I am also aware that I will not be allowed to appear for the examination, if I fail to submit satisfactorily all the assignments, jobs, journals, drawings, reports as specified by the University within stipulated time limit.

- The **Respective Institute** will carry out “**On Line Update**” of the Confirmation of the Candidate's Admission on **DTE** website through their Institute login Immediately when **the Candidate is being admitted at the Institute**.
