Fourth Round of Centralised Allotment Process (CAP Round-IV)
(Admissions for the Academic Year 2006-2007 to the First Year of Four Year
Full Time Degree Courses in Engineering / Technology)

In pursuance of the orders passed by the Hon'ble High Court, Mumbai in the Notice of Motion No. 468 of 2006 in Writ Petition (L) no.1629/2006, dated 1st September 2006, the Directorate of Technical Education is conducting Fourth Round of Centralised Allotment Process (CAP) for the vacant seats that may be available at the start of Round -IV of CAP.

Eligible Candidates :- All Maharashtra State Candidates, whose names have appeared in the Maharashtra State Candidates' Merit list of CAP Round-I and additionally who satisfy any one of the following criteria alone are eligible to apply for this CAP round-IV, provided however that such candidates are not rendered ineligible as set out hereunder :-

1. All such candidate(s), who though were allotted a seat (Maharashtra State Allotment or AIEEE Allotment) in CAP Round-I did not confirm their respective admission(s) due to any reasons, on account of which the seat so allotted had remained vacant and was rendered available for allotment at CAP Round-II.
2. All such candidate(s), who have confirmed their respective admission(s) of CAP Round-I (Maharashtra State Allotment or AIEEE Allotment) and subsequently cancelled the same on or before 22nd August 2006 rendering the seat available for allotment at CAP Round-II.
3. All such candidate(s), to whom any allotment, in all the three rounds of Centralized Allotment Process viz. the CAP Round-I, CAP Round-II And CAP Round-III, was not at all made.

Following candidates are **not eligible** to apply for CAP Round-IV :-

1. All such candidate(s), who were allotted a seat (Maharashtra State Allotment or AIEEE Allotment) in CAP Round-I and who have confirmed their respective admission(s) and were on the roll of the respective institute(s) as on 23rd August, 2006.
2. All such candidate(s), who were allotted a seat (Maharashtra State Allotment or AIEEE Allotment) in CAP Round-II, irrespective of the fact as to whether such candidate(s) have confirmed their respective admission(s) or not.
3. All such candidate(s), who were allotted a seat in CAP Round-III, irrespective of the fact as to whether such candidate(s) have confirmed their respective admission(s) or not.

Seats available: All seats from all the Institutes participating in Centralized Allotment Process (CAP) that is being conducted by the State Government authorities (within the respective sanctioned intake capacity of each of such Institutions) that have remained vacant, on account of whatsoever reason, before the start of CAP Round-IV.

Further it is specifically brought to notice of all the candidates that,

- a) CAP Round-IV will be conducted for Maharashtra State candidates only.
- b) There shall be only one stage of allotment in this Round.
- c) Seats available shall be allotted solely on the basis of inter-se merit determined as per the MHT-CET-2006 merit list without any reference whatsoever to the category of the candidate(s) (open /reserved/male/female) or the category to which the vacant seat belongs.
- d) All available vacant seats shall be treated as 100% State Level seats.

General notes:

1. The aforesaid decision is taken to prevent loss of academics and to make this Round-IV meaningful and effective rather than formal and ineffective in view of the previous experience of the Directorate as also the facts and figures available with the Directorate as to the seats remaining vacant at the end of each Round(s) and especially at the end of all the Round(s) of such Centralised Allotment Process. The round is so designed with the purpose that, maximum vacant seats are filled in, without creating further resultant vacancies on account of shifting of students who have secured admissions in pursuance of allotment made in CAP Round-I and to whom already allotment has been made in CAP Round-II or in CAP Round-III. This step was required to enable the colleges to start the academic activity immediately to complete the term in time.
2. Maximum of only **four (4) choice codes** will be available in the preference form to be submitted for CAP Round-IV.
3. Candidate will be able to take a printout of the online submitted preference form and the same should be confirmed at any of the designated ARCs of CAP Round-II.
4. Candidates are required to pay **Rs.100/- in cash** at ARCs as a processing fee of CAP round-IV as this third round was not contemplated and hence are recovered before the holding of this round.
5. Eligible candidates desiring to participate are required to submit **separate and fresh choice codes** for the CAP Round-IV.
6. **All the Candidate(s) to whom seat(s) will be allotted in this CAP Round-IV will have to accept such allotment and confirm admission so made. This is because all the Candidate(s) to whom seat(s) will be allotted in this CAP Round-IV, irrespective of whether such candidates accept such allotment made or not, will not be eligible for participating in the further process of admission that will be conducted by this Directorate.**
7. In terms of the aforesaid order of the Hon. High Court, referred to at the threshold of this Notification, this Directorate will be conducting the Fifth Round of Centralised Admission Process to be conducted not by way of Centralised Allotment on the basis of multiple option forms but by way of '**personal counseling**'. This Round will be conducted for filling in seats remaining vacant at the end of the ensuing Round-IV and the requisite Notification in that regard will be published in due course.
