ADMISSION NOTIFICATION FOR CAP ROUND-I: ENGINEERING/TECHNOLOGY
Submission of Online Option/Preference Form and Confirmation at ARC for the First Round of Centralized Admission Process (CAP Round-I) of Engineering/Technology Courses for the Academic Year 2007-08

This Notification is being issued for eligible candidates to be admitted in the following Engineering/Technology institutions for the Academic Year 2007-08:-

- State Government/Aided Colleges, University Managed Institutes, University Departments (Except in Five Autonomous Engineering Institutes viz. VJTI, Mumbai; UICT, Mumbai; COE Pune; SGGS IE&T, Nanded & WCE, Sangli)
- Such Unaided colleges and/or such number of seats from Unaided colleges which by mutual consent have decided to form part of this admission process.

Eligible Candidates: All eligible Maharashtra State (MHT-CET 2007 & AIEEE 2007 Paper-1 qualified) candidates and eligible OMS (AIEEE 2007 Paper-1 qualified) candidates, whose names have appeared in the respective final Merit list for CAP Round-I, except the following that are hereby held 'Not Eligible Candidates', are eligible to apply for this round of Centralised Admission by allotment.

A list of candidates, who are eligible to participate in this CAP Round-I, is made available on the website www.dte.org.in/fe2007.

Not Eligible Candidates: Such candidates who have confirmed their respective admission in any one of the Autonomous Institute (viz. VJTI, Mumbai; UICT, Mumbai; COE Pune; SGGS IE&T, Nanded & WCE, Sangli) are not eligible to apply for the CAP Rounds I/II/III/IV. Even if such candidate subsequently cancels their admission, they will not be considered eligible to participate in CAP Rounds I/II/III/IV.

A list of such candidates, who are NOT eligible to participate in this CAP Rounds I/II/III/IV, is also made available on the website www.dte.org.in/fe2007.

Seats available: (For details refer the Information Brochure and website www.dte.org.in/fe2007)

- Seats within sanctioned intake capacity of the State Government/Aided Colleges, University Managed Institutes, University Departments (Except in Five Autonomous Engineering Institutes)
- Seats within sanctioned intake capacity of such Unaided (Both Minority and Non-Minority) colleges and/or such number of seats from such Unaided colleges which by mutual consent have decided to form part of this admission process.

Filling up of the Online Option/Preference Form for CAP Round-I and Confirmation at ARC:

The "Online Option/Preference Form" is being made available to only those eligible candidates, who are eligible of seeking admission to the aforesaid colleges through this Admission Process on the official website:- www.dte.org.in/fe2007.

Aspiring and eligible candidates are required to:-

- Fill in and submit the Online Option/Preference Form for CAP Round-I using own Application-ID and password generated at the time of confirmation of CAP online Application form.
- Take a printout of the Online Option/Preference Form for CAP Round-I and confirm the same at ARC.

3. Confirm the Online Option/Preference form for CAP Round-I ***in person*** along with duly signed printout of the Online Option/Preference form and the Receipt-cum-Acknowledgement letter issued by the ARC at the time of confirmation of CAP online Application form.
4. **Get the Receipt-cum-Acknowledgement letter of the confirmation of the Online Option/Preference form for CAP Round-I duly signed by the ARC officer alongwith seal of that ARC office. Confirmation of online Option form of CAP Round-I is at ARC is MANDATORY for getting allotment (if any).**

Note:

1. Above mentioned 4 steps are **MANDATORY** for all eligible MS candidates (MHT-CET 2007 qualified) and eligible MS & OMS (AIEEE-2007 (Paper-1) qualified candidates. Online submitted Option Form for CAP Round-I, will be considered valid for further processing only after the confirmation of the submission of Online Option Form for CAP Round-I, at ARC. Not confirmed online filled Option Form for CAP Round-I will be rejected. No documents shall be accepted at the ARCs.
2. Eligible AIEEE-2007 (Paper-1) qualified Maharashtra State candidate should fill up separate Option Form for CAP Round-I for admission against AIEEE seats.
3. If the candidate fails to confirm the online filled Option Form for CAP Round-I, then such online filled Option Form for CAP Round-I will be rejected and such candidates will not be eligible to receive any allotment in CAP Round-I.
4. Only one set of 'Rules & Institute Information Brochure for Academic Year 2007-08' will be made available to each eligible applicant **free of cost** at the respective ARC, where the candidate has earlier confirmed the Application form for CAP Admission, on producing the original Receipt-cum-Acknowledgement letter issued by that ARC. Rules & Institute Information Brochure for Academic Year 2007-08 is also available on the website www.dte.org.in/fe2007 for browsing, downloading & printing.
5. The facility for filling Online application form for CAP Round-I is also made available at ARCs.

Reporting after allotment of CAP Round-I:


1. The provisional allotment through CAP Round-I shall be displayed on www.dte.org.in/fe2007, at ARCs and also at the allotted institutes. No separate allotment letter will be issued to candidates.
2. After the display of allotment of CAP Round-I, the candidate should report to the allotted Institutes wherein they have been allotted a seat (if any) as per the schedule given below and the Rules of Reporting for CAP Round-I mentioned in the Information Brochure.
3. Candidates shall report to the allotted institute with **ALL original certificates** needed to substantiate the claims made in the application and the **Receipt-cum-Acknowledgement letter** of Online CAP Application form.
4. If the candidate fails to report to the allotted institute within specified schedule i.e. on or before the last date of reporting after CAP round-I, then such a candidate forfeits the claim on the allotted seat.
5. Principals/Directors of respective institutes are required to carefully scrutinize all the required documents submitted by the candidates at the time of reporting. Any discrepancy in the claims as candidature type, category, eligibility etc. made by the candidates and/or such claims which are not supported by relevant documents should be immediately brought to the notice of the respective Regional Office of the Directorate of Technical Education before confirming the admission of such candidates.
6. The respective Institute will carry out "**Online Update**" of the confirmation of the candidate's admission on DTE website through their Institute login immediately when the candidate is being admitted at the Institute. The system shall automatically generate an acknowledgement for confirmation of the admission. The institute shall take a printout of the receipt and then the status of candidate will change to 'Reported Candidate'.
