TECHNOLOGY FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2007-08.**

Applications are invited from eligible Foreign Nationals/Foreign Students/Persons of Indian Origin (Except citizens of Pakistan and Bangladesh)/Children of Non Resident Indians/Children of Indian Workers in Gulf Countries for admission to first year degree courses in Engineering/Technology in the following autonomous Institutes of Government of Maharashtra/University Department.

Eligibility Criteria

- Candidate should have passed the HSC (Std. XII) examination of Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination with subjects English, Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics and secured minimum 50% marks i. e. not less than 150 out of 300 marks in the subjects Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics added together.
- The eligibility of the candidates passing the HSC(Std. XII) equivalent examination from the school/college/Examination Board situated outside India shall be further decided by University Authorities to which the candidate is admitted. Hence such candidates are advised to get their eligibility verified by respective University Authorities before seeking admission to the Engineering courses in the State of Maharashtra.

Aspiring candidates should download the application form and submit the duly filled form to this office before last date of submission. Please bring one photocopy of the duly filled application form for the purpose of acknowledgement. The candidate should bring all his/her originals at the time of allotment of admission letter for the purpose of verification.

The amount of DD to be attached against application processing fee for Foreign Nationals/Foreign Students/PIO (Except citizens of Pakistan and Bangladesh)/Children of NRI is Rs. 15000/- (Rs. Fifteen thousands only) and for Children of Indian workers in Gulf countries/ candidates of SAARC countries (Except citizens of Pakistan and Bangladesh) is Rs. 5000/- (Rs. Five thousands only).
