Rules & Guidelines to the Participants:

- 3) Submit paper in the following format. Full length paper not exceeding 08 pages of A4 size with margins 1 inch all around in MS Word, Times New Roman, 12 font size, script as per IEEE double column format.
- 4) Front page should clearly specify Event Name, Branch, Paper Name, and Author Name with Name of the Institute.
- 5) **Registration fee in the form of DD of Rs.200 per paper drawn in favour of “Principal, Government Polytechnic, Aurangabad” should be submitted along with paper.**
- 6) Participants should send two hard copies & a soft copy (on CD only) on or before **25th February 09**. They should also send papers as mail attachments.
- 7) 8 minutes will be provided to every team for paper presentation which will be followed by Q & A Session.
- 8) LCD projectors and Computer Setup will be provided at the time of event.
- 9) Participation certificate will be provided to all participants.
- 10) Accommodation will be provided in college hostels as per availability at **Rs.50** per day per person.
- 11) Decision of judges will be final for the prizes.
