**MAH-MBA/MMS-CET 2008**

The MAH-MBA/MMS-CET 2008 will be held on Sunday, 17<sup>th</sup> February 2008.

The candidates appearing for the **MAT to be conducted by AIMA in February 2008** will only be considered eligible for seeking admission to MBA/MMS/PGDBA/PGDBM course in the academic year 2008-09.

**It is clarified that, candidates who have appeared for MAT exams of MAY 2007, SEPT 2007, DEC 2007 and appearing for MAY 2008 will not be considered eligible to seek admission to MBA/MMS/PGDBA/PGDBM courses for the academic year 2008-09.**

**Therefore aspiring candidates are advised to appear for the MAT exam scheduled to be held in February 2008 to become eligible for admission against the All India Seats.**

The eligibility for admission against the All India Seats is (Rule 2.3 of the Information Brochure):

### **2.3 Eligibility<sup>@</sup> Criteria for admission against All India Seats:**

#### **2.3.1 For Maharashtra State Candidates**

1. Candidate should be an Indian National and should possess basic qualification as specified in rule no. 2.1.
2. Appeared for CAT(conducted by IIMs)/JMET(conducted by IITs)/ MAT(conducted by AIMA in February 2008)/ ATMA(conducted by AIMS)/ XAT(conducted by XLRI) for seeking admission to MBA/MMS in the academic year 2008-09. **Such candidates<sup>#</sup> are required to appear for GD &PI conducted by the Competent Authority of Maharashtra State for academic year 2008-09.**

#### **2.3.2 Outside Maharashtra State (OMS) candidates**

(Refer rule no. 3.2 for the definition of Outside Maharashtra State Candidates)

1. Candidate should be an Indian National and should possess basic qualification as specified in rule no. 2.1.
2. Appeared for CAT(conducted by IIMs)/JMET(conducted by IITs)/MAT(conducted by AIMA in February 2008)/ ATMA(conducted by AIMS)/ XAT(conducted by XLRI) for seeking admission to MBA/MMS in the academic year 2008-09. **Such candidates<sup>#</sup> are required to appear for GD &PI conducted by the Competent Authority of Maharashtra State for academic year 2008-09.**

**OR**

Appeared for the Common Entrance Test (MAH-MBA/MMS -CET 2008), GD & PI conducted by the Competent Authority of the Maharashtra State for the academic year 2008-2009.

Note:

- <sup>@</sup> To become eligible for admission the candidate should score 20 or more marks in MAH-MBA/MMS-CET 2008 **OR** equivalent score of 20 marks or more in the All India CET (CAT/JMET/ATMA/XAT/MAT(conducted in February 2008))
- <sup>#</sup> MS & OMS Candidates who have appeared for CAT/JMET/MAT (conducted in February 2008)/ATMA/XAT and seeking admission to MBA/MMS course against All India Seats coming under CAP must fill in & confirm the application form for the CET i.e. MAH-MBA/MMS CET 2008 as per the procedure outlined in Annexure-I. Only such candidates will be permitted to appear for the GD & PI conducted by Competent Authority of the State of Maharashtra and will be eligible to participate in the Centralized Admission Process (CAP).
