The Directorate of Technical Education, Maharashtra State, Mumbai will cancel the admission of the newly allotted candidates if they confirm their admission as per revised allotment list.

If the candidate fails to report to the newly allotted institute as per the date and time mentioned above then such candidates will not have any claim on the newly allotted seat.

If the candidate is eligible for CAP Round-2 as per the eligibility list displayed on the website and if that candidate desires to participate in CAP Round-2 then such candidate is not required to report to the newly allotted institute.

The vacancy for CAP Round-2 will be considered after adjusting the confirmed admissions of the newly allotted candidates.
